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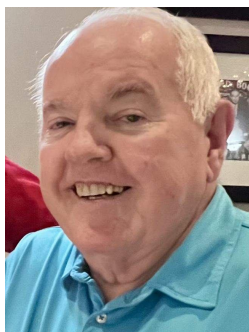

Thank you for making my jubilee so special. The show of love and support is very much appreciated. Know that you all are in my thoughts and prayers daily.

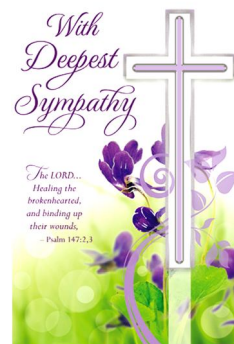
