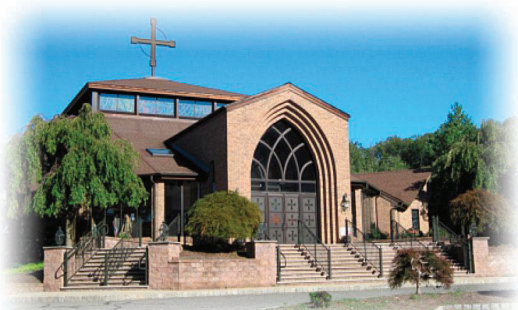

SPIRITUAL LIFE

Faith Formation: The Faith Formation Office will be open on Sunday from 7:30AM to 12:30PM and Monday from 9:00AM to 2:00PM.

Reconciliation: Reconciliation will be celebrated on Saturdays in the Church from 4:30PM to 5:15PM or by appointment with the priest. Parish Penance Services are celebrated during Advent and Lent.

Eucharistic Adoration: First Friday following the 9:00AM Mass until 4:00 PM in the Daily Mass Chapel. Chaplet of the Divine Mercy is prayed at 3:00 PM.

RCIA: The RCIA process is open to those who are interested in becoming Catholic or for those needing to complete the Sacraments of Initiation. All meetings will take place at 1pm in the Rectory. If you are interested, please contact Tom Romano at RCIA@stjudeparish.org.

Anointing of the Sick: At any time, the sacrament of healing is available to all who are seriously ill, hospitalized or preparing for surgery, as well as those of advanced age. Please contact the parish office to make arrangements for administration of the sacrament. If there is an emergency, please call 973-691-1561 Ext 14.

Parish Registration: Is requested of all individual persons and families who worship regularly with us on Sundays and who intend to participate in the life of our parish with their time, talents, and treasure. For more information, call the Parish Office at 973-691-1561 or stop by the Information Office after any Mass on Saturday or Sunday. Registration is necessary for the issuing of sponsor certificates.

Matrimony: Contact the parish office at least nine months before the prospective date.

Baptism: Baptisms are held on Sunday at 1:30PM. Call the parish office to register for class and to schedule Baptism. Baptism Preparation classes will be held quarterly.

Fellowship Prayer Group: Meets every Wednesday from 7:00 – 8:00PM in the Daily Mass Chapel.

Food Drive & Pet Food: Our Monthly Food Drive is held on the First Sunday of the Month and our Pet Food Drive is held on the Third Sunday of the Month. We ask that you bring all non-perishable items and leave them in the church narthex.

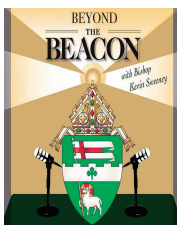

THE SUNDAY READINGS

"The foreigners who join themselves to the Lord, ministering to him, loving the name of the Lord and becoming his servants - all who keep the Sabbath free from profanation and hold to my Covenant, them I will bring to my holy mountain and make joyful in my house of prayer."

Isaiah, writing six centuries before Christ, could very well be speaking of the reality of our church today. We are a nation of immigrants, being served and ministered to by religious from many countries, bringing the gospel of Jesus to build and sustain the church in our country and filling our pews.

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TWENTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Isaiah 22:19-23

This passage refers to the use of authority and indicates the Key as the symbol of authority. The words "open" and "shut" refer to the power that will eventually be given to Peter.

Second Reading: Romans 11:33-36

Paul writes ecstatic and praise-filled words about God's plan for his people. In him, he writes, "all things are."

Gospel: Matthew 16:13-20

When Jesus asks his disciples, "Who do you say that I am?" Peter exclaims, "You are the Messiah!" Christ then declares that Peter is the "Rock" upon which he will build his Church, promising him the power "to bind" and "to loose."
