

Sacrament of Reconciliation

By Appointment Only

Baptisms: Arrangements must be made with the Parish Secretary by calling the Rectory during office hours. Baptism can take place either on a Saturday or Sunday afternoon.

Marriage: Following the Common Policy, a marriage should take place in the parish of either the bride or the groom. Marriage preparation is generally one year. Please call the Rectory as soon as possible after the engagement to discuss your wedding plans.

Hospital Visits and Communion Calls: The Sacrament of the Sick is celebrated twice a year for anyone who may have a chronic condition (October & Easter Season) and is for the healing of body, mind or spirit. If someone is admitted to the hospital, due to the Patient Privacy Law, the priest can only make a visit upon the request of the family. If someone hasn't been to Mass due to illness, please call the Rectory to have a Minister or the priest bring the Eucharist.

Faith Formation is open to all children of the parish. Class is held in the lower church on Sunday morning at 10:00 am to 11:30 am. Any child preparing for a Sacrament (Eucharist or Confirmation), as per Archdiocesan Policy, there is a two-year preparation period. If a child has received the Holy Eucharist but has not kept up with Faith Formation through the years, a test will be administered covering the material before admission into the process for the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Parish Membership: Anyone who worships with us should consider becoming a registered member of the parish. Unfortunately, unless there is a formal registration into parish we are unable to write letters of recommendation and/or fill out sponsor forms for Baptism and Confirmation.

MESSAGE FROM FR. KEVIN

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

What Happened To The Bells? I'm not sure if you know that in the Mass as we have it now, the Novus Ordo, there is no mention of bells to be rung at all except for the Glory To God for the Mass of the Lord's Supper and the Easter Vigil.

In the old liturgy, the Tridentine Mass, the bells were usually a signal that something important was happening in the Mass. If you remember, the Priest had his back to the people and the Mass was in Latin, which very few people understood. Since there was little for the people to do. Some people prayed the Rosary, others perhaps just "vegged out."

The bells were rung to call attention to something that was happening at the Altar. The bells were first rung at the Sanctus (Holy, Holy) to tell the people to kneel for the Eucharistic Prayer. The next time the bells were rung was at the invocation of the Holy Spirit, to change the elements of Bread and Wine into the Body and Blood of the Lord. Then the bells were rung at the elevations of the Host and the Chalice. In the old Mass, there was a genuflection, elevation, and genuflection for both the Host and the Chalice. Finally, the bells were rung when the Priest consumed the contents of the Chalice.

Prior to the Pandemic, when we had a few Altar Servers, it was the job of the server to ring the bells. Currently, we have no Altar Servers, hence no bells. Recently, a Parishioner at the 9 AM Mass, has been getting the bells from the sacristy and ringing them from his place in the Church at the invocation of the Holy Spirit and the two elevations. I am open to other Parishioners doing the same. If anyone feels so inclined, perhaps a volunteer at the 4:30 PM or the 12 Noon Mass or even at the weekday Masses might be willing to ring them from their place in the congregation. Just let me know!
