## ***Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,***

This coming **Wednesday, February 18<sup>th</sup>** is **ASH WEDNESDAY**, the start of the holy and penitential season of **Lent**.

The Church proscribes “**3 Pillars**” to assist us during Lent:

1. **Prayer**
2. **Fasting**
3. **Almsgiving**

It is said that each of these practices helps us to heal a fundamental relationship:

1. **Prayer** – helps heal our relationship with God
2. **Fasting** – helps heal our relationship with ourselves
3. **Almsgiving** – helps heal our relationship with others



I remember as a school child here at St. Theresa School, during Lent we would have collection boxes in the classrooms for alms for the poor and the missions. *One of the teachers encouraged us to consider something as simple as the 50¢ it cost then for a bag of potato chips at lunch, to sacrifice this treat to help the poor. She taught us that if we couldn't say no in small ways like to a bag of chips, how could we resist larger temptations.* This lesson still stays with me today, and I am grateful for the Catholic Education I received here at St. Theresa School, which this year would be celebrating its **60<sup>th</sup> anniversary**.

Please take note that next weekend, we welcome back **Fr. Glenn Sudano, CFR** who will be preaching at all the Sunday Masses in anticipation for our **3-Night Parish Mission** that he'll be leading, which runs **Monday – Wednesday, February 23<sup>rd</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup> at 7pm each evening**. You are invited and highly encouraged to attend this Mission with your family and friends as an opportunity for prayer, repentance, and renewal this Lenten season.

## SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

### First Reading: Sirach 15:15-20

This passage from Sirach gives strong, unequivocal emphasis to free will in every person. Before each of us is set, sin or virtue, life or death, and each of us are free to choose the one or the other.

### Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 2:6-10

Paul explains to the Corinthians that there are two different kinds of wisdom — the wisdom of God and the wisdom of the world. The wisdom of God is mysterious, but this wisdom has been revealed “to those who love him” through the Spirit.

### Gospel: Matthew 5:17-37

In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus tells the people he has come to fulfill the law. He speaks strongly against murder and anger, against adultery and lust, and against false oaths and lies. He warns the people that unless their virtue exceeds that of the Pharisees, they “will not enter the kingdom of God.”

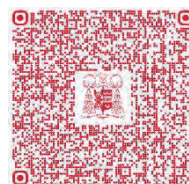

**FASTING AND ABSTINENCE**

Please see below an explanation of these Lenten regulations:

**FASTING** requires that only one full meal be taken per day. Two other smaller meals may be taken during the day to maintain physical strength, but these two meals together should not equal a full meal in quantity. Nor is there eating between meals. Fasting obliges all those who have reached the age of 18 and continues to oblige through age 59. Those who are not specifically obliged to fast are encouraged to join in the discipline of fasting to the extent that they are able.

**ABSTINENCE** prohibits individuals from eating meat on a particular day. Abstinence obliges all those who have reached the age of 14 and continues to oblige throughout their lives. Those who are not specifically obliged to abstain from eating meat are encouraged to join in the discipline of abstaining to the extent that they are able.

## Saint Perpetua

(c. 182-203) Martyr, Feast Day March 7

*“I cannot be called any other name than what I am – a Christian” – St. Perpetua*

This window was donated in memory of Robert J. McGee.

Perpetua is pictured in noble Roman attire, indicated by the purple cloak. She carries a palm branch, which indicates her martyrdom. The blue sash symbolizes her purity and motherhood. When we hear St. Perpetua commemorated at Mass, it is alongside St. Felicity [aka Felicitas] and their companion martyrs, who were martyred in A.D. 203 in Carthage under Emperor Severus.

At the time of her arrest with 5 other catechumens, Perpetua was a 22-year-old recently married wife and mother of a young baby.

Her father, a pagan, did everything he could out of affection for his favorite daughter to convince her to preserve her earthly life by sacrificing to the Roman gods, but she would not betray or deny her faith.

Sentenced to death, Perpetua and her companions were sent to the arena where, after being mauled by wild animals, she and Felicity were killed by gladiators. From a vision the day before, Perpetua knew the real enemy she battled was not beasts, but the Devil. She is a patron saint of mothers and expectant mothers. St. Perpetua, pray for us.
