

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Our Lord has risen from the tomb! Alleluia, Alleluia! How can we not but overflow with joy this Easter, for He has arisen from the dead, and now our lives have meaning, have hope, have a glorious future. Let me paraphrase to you from one of the great ancient liturgies of the Church, the joy of all of us who are His.



Christ is risen from the dead, trampling death by death and upon those in the tombs bestowing life. **He has dispelled death by death and is our true Passover, for from death to life and from earth to heaven has Christ our true God led us!** Yesterday we were buried with Christ; today we rise with Him in the Resurrection. Yesterday we were crucified with Him; today we ask Him to glorify us with Him, Our Savior in His Kingdom.

Let us join Mary Magdalene and the other women, this Easter morning. They found the stone rolled away. Let us hear what the Angelic voice said to them "Why do you seek the Living One among the dead, why do you mourn He who is incorrupt of incorruption? Why do you seek the Living One among the dead as a man? The One Who is everlasting light?"

Behold the cloths in the grave and **go and proclaim to the world, the Lord is risen!** He has slain death by death as He is the Son of God, saving the race of men!"

Let us arise before dawn and bring the Master, a hymn instead of myrrh and **we too shall see Christ, the Sun of Righteousness, Who causes life to dawn for all.** O Lord, we venerate Your Cross, O Christ, and glorify Your Holy Resurrection, **for You are Our God and we know no other than You!** O come let us venerate Christ's Resurrection, for behold, through the Cross, joy has come into the whole world. Let us ever bless the Lord, praising His Holy Resurrection, for by enduring the Cross for us He has destroyed death by death. **Jesus has Risen form the tomb, as He foretold, granting us eternal life and great mercy!**

All of you will be remembered at Our Easter Masses by your priests.

May all of you have a Blessed Easter, the Passover of Christ! *Fr. Paul*

FIRST READING: ACTS 10:34A, 37-43

In this passage, Peter testifies that he and his followers saw the miracles performed by Christ, witnessed His death, and believe in His resurrection. Now they will proclaim to all that Christ is the Son of God.

SECOND READING: COLOSSIANS 3:1-4

Paul tells the Colossians that they will appear with Christ in glory. They should be mindful of things above rather than things on earth.

GOSPEL: JOHN 20:1-9

In vivid detail, John tells us that when Mary Magdalene visited Christ's tomb, the tomb was empty. She told the apostles, who ran to the tomb, and saw the "wrappings" on the ground. The disciple who entered first "saw and believed."

DIVINE MERCY NOVENA & CELEBRATION



Our Lord instructed St. Faustina to encourage souls to pray the divine mercy chaplet beginning on Good Friday ending on the Second Sunday of Easter "Divine Mercy Sunday". **(Divine Mercy Novena pamphlets are at the doors of the church.)**

In his message to St Faustina Kowalska, Jesus promised for this Sunday that: "on that day the very depths of my tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of my mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete pardon of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which grace flows are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to me, even though it sins be scarlet." (Diary, n.699)

How can we celebrate properly this Divine Mercy Sunday? First, by going to Confession (or making sure we have gone during this Lenten/Easter season), and then by receiving Communion, and preparing ourselves to receive the presence of Our Lord with great expectancy. We shall also not fail to honor the mercy of our Lord by venerating the Image of Divine Mercy and by our prayers and works of mercy today. That image which our Lord called "a vessel to which people are to keep coming for graces from the fountain of mercy," and is inscribed with the words "Jesus, I trust in You," is displayed in our church in the Sanctuary. Next Sunday, April 12th at 2pm, we will have a special Holy Hour in honor of our Lord's Divine Mercy. Priests will be available for confession. Why not come and honor the One who frees those who ask from the slavery of sin and grants immeasurable graces?
