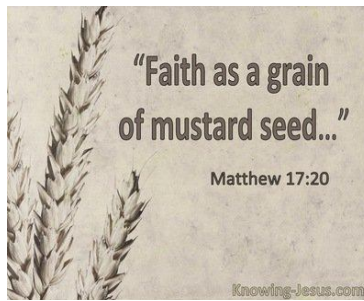

SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME ✦ JULY 19, 2020

First Reading: Wisdom 12:13, 16-19 ✦ Second Reading: Romans 8:26-27

Gospel: Matthew 13:24-43



In this weekend's Gospel, Jesus gives us a parable that also teaches us about some seeds. As we know, seeds come in all varieties such as flower seeds, vegetable seeds, heirloom seeds, garden and plant seeds. Some seeds we plant and some seeds we eat, such as sunflower seeds, poppy seeds and pumpkin seeds. Here in the United States, through the U.S. Department of Agriculture, we currently have 20 seed gene banks that preserve and protect hundreds of thousands of major crop seeds, vital to the future of U.S. agriculture. By now I would suppose that many of us have already planted our more common vegetable seeds and are seeing our tomato, cucumber, pepper and bean plants emerging from the good soil. As Jesus also points out in his parable, we have to be on the outlook for those weeds which can play havoc to our vegetable plants. Effective weed control is key to growing healthy garden plants as we know.

Jesus' parable in this weekend's Gospel is referred to as the parable of the weeds among the wheat. It's plain and simple message is that there does exist evil in the world. For centuries we have been asking the age old question: Why does God permit evil in the world? We ask the common question of today: Why is there violence and hatred in our society? Even the great theologian and intellect St. Augustine asked this question and tried to find an equitable answer. Eventually, he realized that evil is a product of humankind's frailty, as well as sinfulness and the only solution was to rise above it by believing in God, trusting in Jesus and (as we pray in the 'Our Father' prayer) ask the Father to deliver us from all evil.

Jesus also assures us that in the end evil will be destroyed, especially the greatest evil that we know of which is death, why because Jesus has already won the victory over evil through his Resurrection.

So my friends, let us get back to our gardening, not in the traditional sense, but as believers who are given the task of weeding out the evil around us by growing the Kingdom of Heaven here on earth by participating in small acts of faith and kindness that will succeed in effectively controlling and choking out the evil weeds of our society.

May the Lord grant you his peace.

## CURRENT PROCEDURES FOR ATTENDING MASS AT ST. ANNE'S

1. **Weekday Masses have resumed with the following directives:**
  - a. The maximum number of people who can be present is 50.
  - b. A mask **MUST** be worn and a distance of six feet must be maintained between persons outside individual families.
  - c. **Registration is REQUIRED.** To best protect the safety and wellness of our entire parish, the Archdiocese has mandated a registration system that will allow us to contact trace in the event that anyone becomes ill. You will be able to sign up for Masses in weekly blocks on EVENTBRITE. You can access EVENTBRITE by going to our webpage: [www.stannefairlawnnj.org](http://www.stannefairlawnnj.org) and selecting Masses you would like to attend.
  - d. When Mass is over, please leave promptly so that we can immediately begin sanitizing the Church.
2. **We have resumed TWO weekend Masses, on Saturday at 5:15 p.m., and Sunday at 9:30 a.m. with the same provisions as weekday Masses (see above).**
3. **Baptisms, weddings, and funerals can be resumed with all cautionary social-distancing measures in place.** Based on state public official guidelines, the maximum number of participants for Funeral, Baptisms and Weddings remains at 25% of the church's capacity or 50 participants in total, whichever number is lower, which in our case is 50 maximum.
4. **The Church will remain open for private prayer at the following times daily until 1:00 pm.**

Please be aware that there still will be a risk for anyone who attends a Mass. Even with the best health practices and strict social distancing, anyone who enters a public space should recognize there is a risk of contracting the coronavirus.

We want to make every effort to ensure that these health practices will be followed by us. So, we all need to cooperate with each other. We are limited to the amount of people in church at each service. So that's why we have to register for the Mass we want to go to. We'll also be adding new greeters to help the ushers find a place for you to be during Mass. After any service, we will sanitize the church and bathrooms. I'm sure that if we follow these protocols, we can reduce the risks.

We want to thank you all for your patience and understanding. We realize that these precautions are inconvenient and cumbersome. However, our greatest priority is to help us all to worship in a setting where we all feel safe and secure. Thank you! We look forward to seeing your faces again!

Here you can choose to have the funds deducted from your checking or bank account (you will need your routing and account numbers on hand). Under **Manage My Account**, you will also see **Give a New Gift**. There you will decide when and how much to give. (In the list, Offertory Collection means the Sunday collection.) You can select recurring or one time gifts. You also have the option to access all the other special envelopes you would normally find in your envelope packet and which are generally one-time donations.

Each time you go to Mass, get a card that says “I have made my donation online” and put it in the collection when the usher comes around. Thanks so much for giving online!
