Lourdes. France

You may be aware by now that I have scheduled a pilgrimage trip for our parish and others who may be interested in going from October 13th to the 22nd of this year. The pilgrimage that we will embark on is mainly to the Marian Shrines of Our Lady of Lourdes and Our Lady of Fatima. Both of these Marian Shrines are related to our Blessed Mother's Apparitions that took place at both locations. First, Our Blessed Mother appeared to a young girl named Bernadette Soubirous in a series of about 18 apparitions at Lourdes, France from February 11th until July 16th in the year 1858. We will visit the home of St. Bernadette and the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception, the title Mary used to identify herself to St. Bernadette. We will also join in a candlelight procession to the grotto where Mary appeared. Second, Our Blessed Mother appeared to three young shepherd children in Fatima, Portugal once a month from May 13th until October 13th in the year 1917. The names of the three children were Lucia, Francesco and Jacinta. We will also visit their childhood home and celebrate mass at the Chapel of Apparitions.

A pilgrimage is more than a vacation trip or excursion. It is defined as a sacred journey undertaken to a holy place or site for spiritual growth, personal transformation or religious devotion. A pilgrimage can be a life-changing experience as well. Our purpose for this pilgrimage is that and more. It will give us an opportunity to experience the healing presence of God for our own needs, or to offer our pilgrimage journey for the needs of others who were not able to join us. In addition, we will travel to the city of Loyola, Spain the birthplace of St. Ignatius, the founder of the Jesuit Order, or the Society of Jesus.

We will also travel to the capital city of Barcelona, Spain. There we will travel to the world-famous unfinished church "La Sagrada Familia" or the Holy Family church, one of the most impressive churches in the world. It recently became the tallest church in the world after the placement of the church spire. It is considered as one of Antoni Gaudi's greatest masterpieces. Gaudi (1852-1926) who was a devout Catholic is considered one of Spain's greatest builders and architects in all of history.

Our pilgrimage will be a memorable experience for sure. Mass will be celebrated each day. Breakfast and dinner will be included, as well as all tips. We will have professional tour guides along the way and will be staying in first-class hotels throughout. The price per person based on double occupancy is \$4,399. Single occupancy will be a little bit higher. Round-trip airfare is included and I'll arrange for ground transportation from St. Anne Church to Newark Liberty International Airport and back. which sets us free.


STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

Once you are taken to the new site, click on the section that says **Create New Account**.


Next you will see **New User Account Registration**. Fill out the form and click "submit."


