FROM THE PASTORS' DESK

NOVEMBER 1, 2020

We begin this month with the feasts of All Saints and All Souls. A time when we remember, in a special way, all those, marked with the sign of faith, who have gone to sleep in the Peace of Christ. It is a time when we give thanks to God for the gift of faith and to thank Him for all those who have passed their faith on to us. It is the feast of grandpa and grandma, of our family throughout the ages. A feast of all those who taught us how to bless ourselves, our daily prayers, of where we come from, and of who we are. It is a time to remember those who first taught us what the manger scene was under the Christmas Tree, of the Wise Men who traveled far (from across the living room in my house) to seek the Christ Child and to present their gifts to the Divine Infant. It is the feast day of all those who taught us the meaning of kindness, who were the first to share our sorrows and our joys, who taught us the values of morals and decency, of truthfulness and integrity.

It is a time of reflection about ourselves as well. To ask ourselves, honestly, evaluate our lives and what we are passing on to the next generation. What values are we leaving our young-what we are teaching them is really important in this life-not simply in words but the examples we are setting by our actions. I fear that we could be doing a whole lot better.

As to what is going on in the parish. I want to thank the Knights of Columbus for their generous donation of \$5,000 from their Octoberfest. More importantly I want to thank them for all they do throughout the year for the church. Their presence and the good works they do are an inspiration for all of us. I truly urge all the men of the parish to consider joining this worthwhile Catholic organization. You will not be wasting your time. I also want to thank our parishioner Mrs. Newman for her generous donation of time, talent and material, for making beautiful masks for our school. Masks have become a part of our everyday life. Mrs. Newman has made masks embroidered with the school seal for all of the faculty, staff and student body of the school. The children look wonderful in them.

I also want to say something about mass attendance. We have gone from a little over 2,000 each Sunday to an average of, around, 700 each Sunday. I realize that the governor has limited the number of people we can hold in the churches, and, due to the need of sanitizing after each mass, the number of masses we can have, but this is a situation that, as your pastor, I think is very sad indeed. Coming together as a community is what we as a Church are all about. I understand that the church has lifted the ban to physical presence at mass obligation and allowed viewing the mass on TV but that is a poor substitute for "being there". I know the fear that some have but I can assure you that you are safer in attending mass than in going to the super market or Wal-Mart. We sanitize the church after each mass and do a general spray disinfecting of the building each week. Hand sanitizer is available at both churches and all are required to wear masks at mass. It is more comfortable attending mass in the comfort of your own home but it lacks the aspect of "community". After all Christ commanded us to do this in memory of him. Not private prayer but private prayer and gathering together around the table. I urge you to consider coming back to mass and to petition the governor to lift the distancing requirements for attending religious services.

Finally, it is obvious that we as a church rely upon the generosity of our people and of your generous donations to our parish. I have a request. If you wish to do something to commemorate a deceased loved one, please DO NOT be talked into buying vestments, chalices, ciboria and the like. Honestly, we do not need any of those items and they will not be used here at St. James. Please consider talking to the parish staff about what we do need before you memorialize any items. Presently we have a donation being made for a statue of St. Michael, the patron saint of Police Personnel, to be placed in the Memorial Garden. I would also like to have a statue of St. Florian, patron saint of Firefighters to be placed in that same garden. Donations to such a memorial would be greatly appreciated. Sorry for the length of these rantings. Stay safe and healthy and God bless you all.

Parish Office Information

The Parish Office is opened on Monday thru Friday from 8am to 5pm, Saturday 9am to 3pm and Sunday 8am - 3pm. To ensure that we meet social distance regulations, **we will utilize the Office Window for business.** You must wear a mask at the window and at all times while in the building.

Our **2021 Mass Book is open.** We are limiting each family to six (6) masses: **Only (3) weekend masses will be allowed and only (3) weekday masses. Only (3) 9:00am masses are permitted. However, if you prefer early morning you may have (6) at 7:30am.** We have limited masses because last February we ran out of 2020 weekend masses and are hoping to avoid that for 2021.

In addition to Mass Cards, another option is our memorial donations for either a Sanctuary Candle or Bread and Wine. We discounted the prices as we do not have any 2020 masses available. These donations may also be used to honor a family member or a friend.

ST. SEBASTIAN'S COLUMBARIUM AND TERRACE

A Columbarium is a Latin word, which describes a collection of niches to house urns containing cremated human remains. The niches are inscribed with the person's name and dates of birth and death. They are constructed to serve as permanent resting places for your loved ones in a "churchyard" setting.

The price of a niche is \$2,500, which allows you to inter the cremains of two people. To date we have celebrated 163 interment services at the Altar of our Terrace and Columbarium. We have sold 269 Niches and have 186 Niches available for purchase.

READINGS FOR THIS WEEK

THE 31TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

ALL SAINTS

First Reading: Revelations 7:2-4, 9-14

John recounts the details of his vision. An angel bearing the seal of the living God demands that the land and sea not be destroyed; huge crowds stand before the throne of the Lamb crying out that salvation comes from God; angels gathered round and praised God. An elder questions John and he explains that those dressed in white are the ones who have survived the great period of trial.

Second Reading: 1 John 3:1-3

John speaks to us of love. He points out the great love that the Father has for us by allowing us to be called children of God. John explains that the world doesn't recognize us because it never recognized Jesus.

Gospel: Matthew 5:1-12a

When Jesus saw the crowds of people, he went up to the mountainside gathered his disciples around him and began to teach them. This lesson in love has come to be known to us as the great "Sermon on the Mount" or "The Beatitudes."

READINGS FOR NEXT WEEK

First Reading: Wisdom 6:12-16

Regarded as personifying God's power, Wisdom is readily and easily found by those who seek her.

Second Reading: 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18

The Thessalonians, who fear that those who have died will miss Christ's return, are comforted by Paul's assurance that those "who have died in Christ will rise first."

Gospel: Matthew 25:1-13

In the parable of the five sensible bridesmaids and the five foolish bridesmaids, Jesus emphasizes the fact that we must always be ready for the coming of Christ because in his words, "You know not the day or the hour."

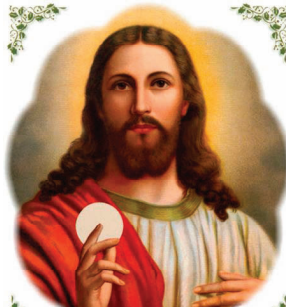
We ask for ears that will hear the cries of children unborn and those abandoned, men and women oppressed because of race or creed, religion, or gender.

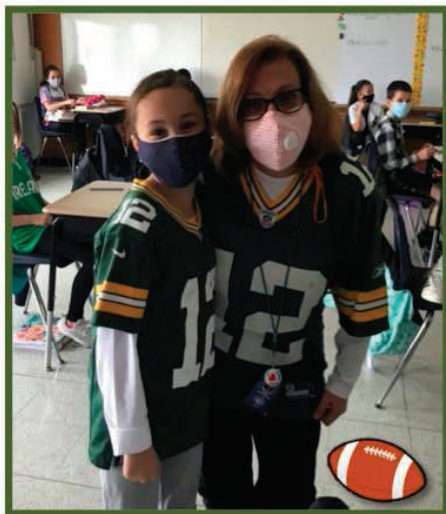

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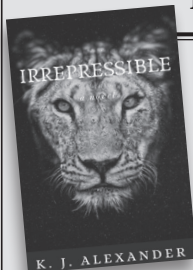


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
