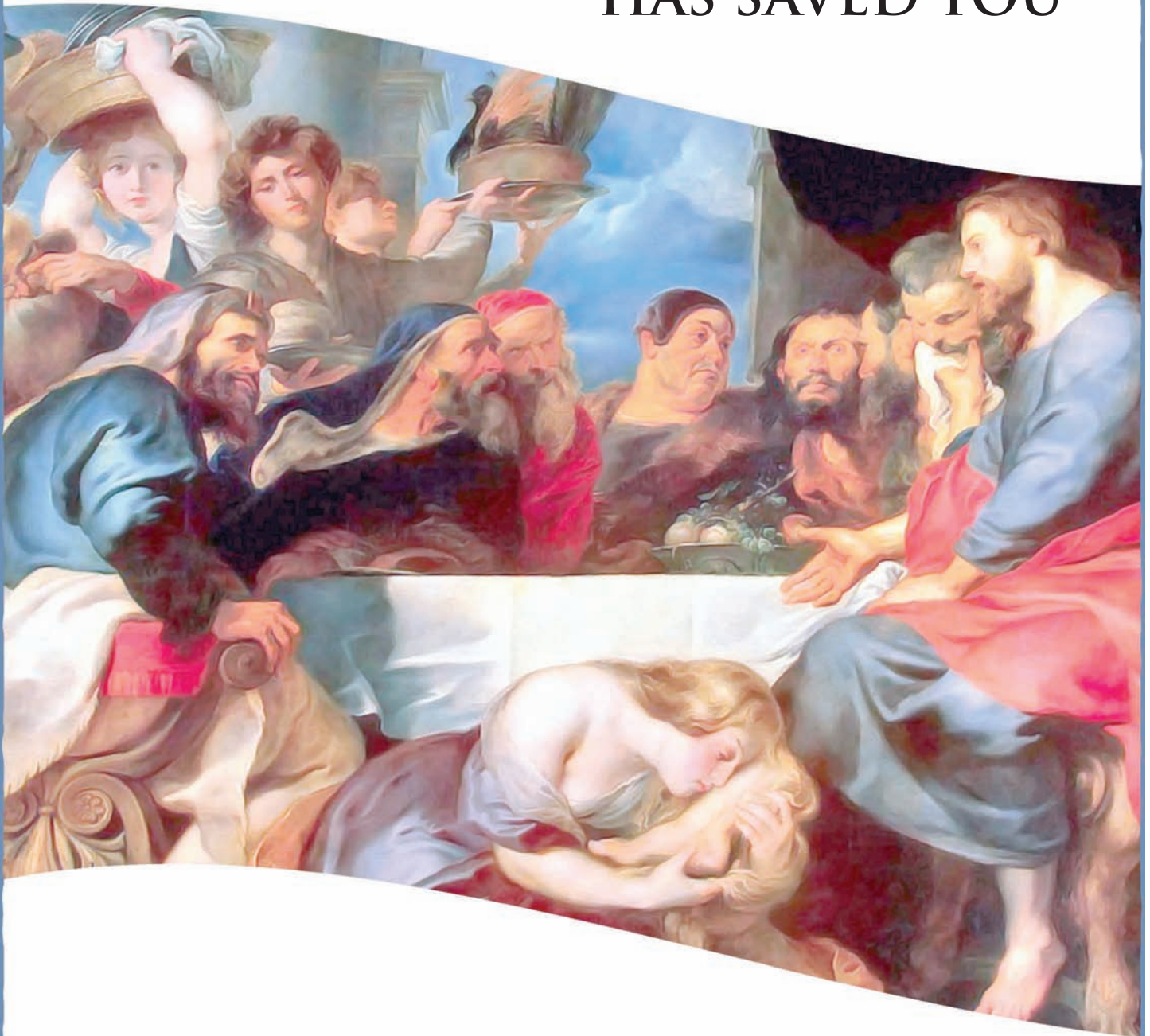

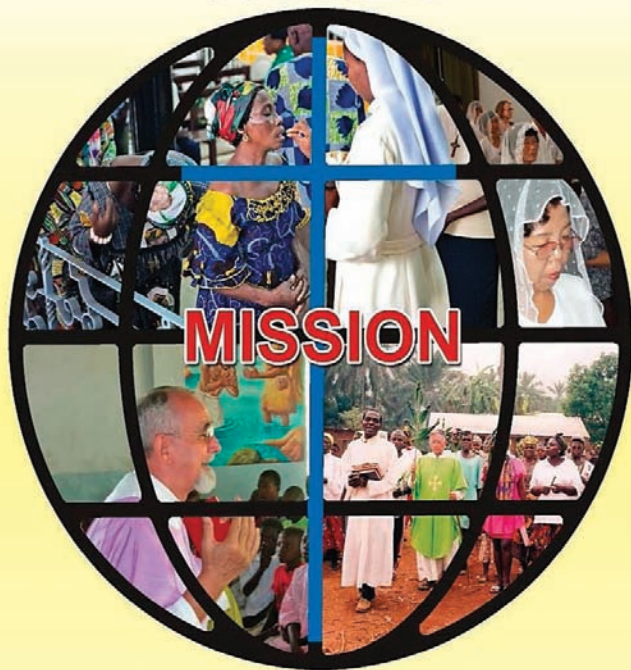

The Lord said, "Pay attention to what the dishonest judge says.

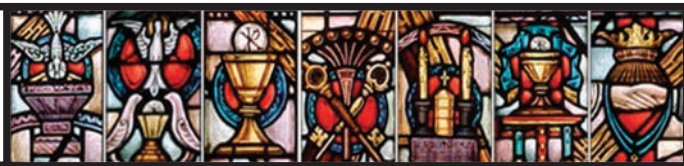

## SACRAMENTAL LIFE AT ST. PAUL



**BAPTISM:** Baptisms in English are celebrated every 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday of the month at 1:00pm and 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday during Mass at 9:00am and 11:00am. Baptisms in Spanish are celebrated every 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday of the month at 1:00pm and 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday at 1:00pm (Spanish Mass). Parents and Godparents are required to attend one Baptismal Preparation Class, if Godparents are not registered parishioners in St. Paul Church, they must bring a sponsor Letter from their Parish. First requirement is that the parents must bring an original birth certificate when meeting with the Pastor or Deacon to schedule a Baptism. **RECONCILIATION:** The Sacrament of Reconciliation is celebrated every Saturday from 4:15pm to 4:55pm in the Church. Personal appointments may be made by contacting the parish office.

**MARRIAGE:** The Sacrament of Matrimony is celebrated Wednesday to Friday from 1:00pm to 5:00pm, Saturday from 1:00pm to 2:00pm and Sunday from 3:30pm to 5:00pm. We must be contacted one year prior to the date of the wedding. In your initial meeting with the Pastor or Deacon, couples must bring the following documents: updated Baptismal, First Communion, and Confirmation certificate. **ANOINTING OF THE SICK:** The Sacrament of the sick is celebrated the first weekend of every month at the end of all the Masses. But, if you prefer other arrangements, please contact the parish office.

*In cases of illness, please notify us if you or a family member would like to receive Holy Communion at home. The Pastor visits the sick twice a month. Please notify the Parish Office at 973-340-1300.*

**RELIGIOUS EDUCATION:** The Religious Education Program provides religious formation and sacramental preparation for children of our parish in Grades 1 through 11. For more information contact our Parish Office.

**RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION (RCIA) FOR ADULTS:** A process of Liturgical and Spiritual formation for those seeking to receive the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. For more information, please contact our Parish Office.

Los documentos que deben traer son: Certificado original de Bautismo, Primera Comunión y Confirmación. Las parejas de novios deben empezar a prepararse con un año de anterioridad. ## GOSPEL REFLECTION

Jesus tells a story that is all too true—a defenseless widow is taken advantaged of and refused her rights. Through sheer persistence she wears down an unscrupulous judge until he gives her justice. Persistence pays off, and that's especially true for those who trust in God. Jesus illustrates how God as our Judge is much quicker to bring us his justice, blessing, and help when we need it. But we can easily lose heart and forget to ask our Heavenly Father for his grace and help. Jesus told this parable to give fresh hope confidence to his disciples. In this present life we can expect trials and adversity, but we are not without hope in God.

The Last Judgment will reveal that God's justice triumphs over all the injustices perpetrated by his creatures and that God's love is stronger than death (Song of Songs 8:6). The just can look forward with hope to that day when they will receive their reward. Jesus ends his parable with a probing question for us. Will you and I have faith—the faith that perseveres to the end—of time when Jesus returns in glory to judge the living and the dead? Faith is an entirely free gift that God makes to us. If we want to live, grow, and persevere in the faith until the end, then we must nourish it with the word of God and ask the Lord to increase it (Luke 17:5).

**For Reflection:** *When trials and setbacks disappoint you, where do you place your hope? Do you pray with expectant faith and confidence in God's merciful care and providence for you?*

**Prayer:** *"Lord, give me faith to believe your promises and give me perseverance and hope to withstand trials and adversities. Help me to trust in your unfailing love and to find joy and contentment in you alone."*

### **10 SIGNS OF A SAFE PROGRAM FOR CHILDREN & YOUTH**

1. Screening of staff/ volunteers.
2. Adults trained in safe environment strategies and signs of abuse.
3. Code of conduct enforced.
4. Open Communication between parents and staff/ staff and children/ children and parents.
5. Parents always Welcome.
6. Children educated in right relationship & what to do if a relationship isn't right.
7. All children treated with Dignity and Respect.
8. Clear Rules and Expectations. Consistent reinforcement / consequences
9. Adequate supervision of youth. Team approach--- accountability---no 1:1 isolation
10. All abuse is reported

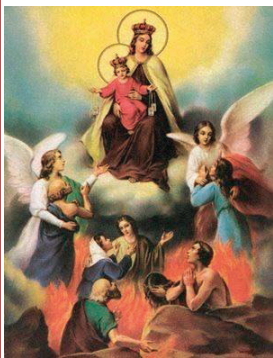
