

TODAY'S GOSPEL

John the Baptist saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world. He is the one of whom I said, 'A man is coming after me who ranks ahead of me because he existed before me.' I did not know him, but the reason why I came baptizing with water was that he might be made known to Israel." John testified further, saying, "I saw the Spirit come down like a dove from heaven and remain upon him. I did not know him, but the one who sent me to baptize with water told me, 'On whomever you see the Spirit come down and remain, he is the one who will baptize with the Holy Spirit.' Now I have seen and testified that he is the Son of God."

SACRAMENTAL LIFE AT ST. PAUL



BAPTISM: Baptisms in English are celebrated every 2nd Saturday of the month at 1:00pm and 2nd Sunday during Mass at 9:00am and 11:00am. Baptisms in Spanish are celebrated every 4th Saturday of the month at 1:00pm and 4th Sunday at 1:00pm (Spanish Mass). Parents and Godparents are required to attend one Baptismal Preparation Class, if Godparents are not registered parishioners in St. Paul Church, they must bring a sponsor Letter from their Parish. First requirement is that the parents must bring an original birth certificate when meeting with the Pastor or Deacon to schedule a Baptism. RECONCILIATION: The Sacrament of Reconciliation is celebrated every Saturday from 4:15 pm to 4:55 pm in the Church. Personal appointments may be made by contacting the parish office.

MARRIAGE: The Sacrament of Matrimony is celebrated Wednesday to Friday from 1:00pm to 5:00pm, Saturday from 1:00 pm to 2:00 pm and Sunday from 3:30 pm to 5:00 pm. We must be contacted one year prior to the date of the wedding. In your initial meeting with the Pastor or Deacon, couples must bring the following documents: updated Baptismal, First Communion, and Confirmation certificate. ANOINTING OF THE SICK: The Sacrament of the sick is celebrated the first weekend of every month at the end of all the Masses. But, if you prefer other arrangements, please contact the parish office.

GOSPEL REFLECTION

With the feast of the Baptism of the Lord, celebrated last Sunday, we have entered the liturgical season called "ordinary". On this second Sunday, the Gospel presents us with the scene of the encounter between Jesus and John the Baptist, on the banks of the Jordan River. The one who relates it is the eyewitness, John the Evangelist, who before being a disciple of Jesus was a disciple of the Baptist, together with his brother James, with Simon and Andrew, all from Galilee, all fishermen. The Baptist, therefore, sees Jesus advancing through the crowd and, inspired from on high, recognizes in him the one sent by God, and therefore indicates him with these words: "This is the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world" (Jn 1:29).

The verb translated "quita" literally means "to relieve", "to take upon oneself".


Jesus came into the world with a precise mission: to free it from the slavery of sin, taking upon himself the sins of humanity. How? Loving. There is no other way to overcome evil and sin if not with the love that impels us to the gift of one's life for others. In the testimony of John the Baptist, Jesus has the traits of the Servant of the Lord, who "endured our sufferings and endured our sorrows" (Is 53:4), even to the point of dying on the Cross. He is the true paschal lamb, who immerses himself in the river of our sin, to purify us.

The Baptist sees before him a man who stands in line with sinners to be baptized, even if he is not necessary. A man whom God sent into the world as a lamb slain. In the New Testament the term "lamb" is found on more than one occasion, and always in relation to Jesus. This image of the lamb might be astonishing. In fact, an animal that is certainly not characterized by its strength and robustness if it carries such an unbearable weight on its own shoulders. The enormous mass of evil is removed and carried away by a weak and fragile creature, a symbol of obedience, docility and defenseless love, which goes so far as to sacrifice itself. The lamb is not a dominator but is docile; it is not aggressive, but peaceful; it does not show its claws or teeth in the face of any attack but endures and is docile. And that's Jesus. That's Jesus, like a lamb.

What does it mean for the Church, for us, today, to be disciples of Jesus the Lamb of God? It means putting innocence in the place of malice; in the place of strength, love; in the place of pride, humility; in the place of prestige, service. It's a good job. We Christians must do this: put in the place of malice, innocence, in the place of strength, love, in the place of pride, humility, in the place of prestige, service. To be disciples of the Lamb does not mean to live as a "besieged citadel", but as a city located in the mountains, open, welcoming and supportive. It means not assuming attitudes of closure, but proposing the Gospel to everyone, witnessing with our lives that following Jesus makes us freer and more joyful.







7. All children treated with Dignity and Respect.
8. Clear Rules and Expectations. Consistent reinforcement / consequences
9. Adequate supervision of youth. Team approach---accountability---no 1:1 isolation
10. All abuse is reported
