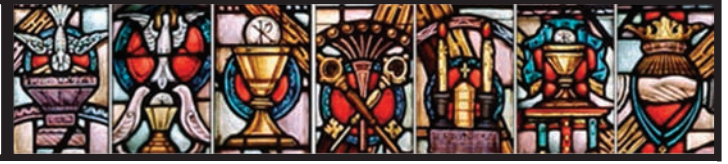

Baptisms in Spanish are celebrated every 4<sup>th</sup> Saturday of the month at 1:00 pm and 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday at 1:00 pm (Spanish Mass). Parents and Godparents are required to attend one Baptismal Preparation Class, if Godparents are not registered parishioners in St. Paul Church, they must bring a sponsor Letter from their Parish. First requirement is that the parents must bring an original birth certificate when meeting with the Pastor or Deacon to schedule a Baptism. ## GOSPEL REFLECTION

The Lord wanted to refute with his actions the accusation of the Pharisees when they said, "In the name of the prince of demons, he casts out demons," for the devil does not take revenge by doing good to those who insult him, but by harming them. And the Lord does the opposite; since he does not punish, nor even rebuke, those who insult and revile him, but rather showers them with blessings, that is why it is said, "And Jesus went throughout all the cities and castles": in which he teaches us not to respond to an accusation with another accusation, but to respond with good deeds. He who, after being accused, ceases to do good, implies that he does good for the applause of men, but if we constantly do good to our fellow human beings, whoever they may be, we will have a very great reward.

This is not all the goodness of Christ, but by opening the depths of his mercy towards those people, he shows them the concern he has for them, according to those words: "And when he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them." This is the condemnation of the princes of the Jews, for although they were shepherds they behaved like wolves, because not only did they not correct the people, but they also harmed them as much as they could for their own benefit, that is why the people said with admiration: "Nothing like this has ever happened in Israel" and the Pharisees, on the contrary: "cast out the demon in the name of the prince of demons."

Jesus openly declares himself Lord of the harvest. While it is true that he commands the Apostles to reap the harvest they did not sow, he does not command them to reap someone else's harvest, but rather those whose seeds he himself sowed through the prophets. Yet, with only twelve Apostles, he exclaimed, "Pray to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest." And although he did not increase the number of workers, he multiplied them, not in terms of quantity, but in terms of the power he gave them.

He reveals to us how great the grace of being called to preach the word of God appropriately, telling us that this is the purpose of our prayers. In this passage, he refers to John's words about the ark, the winnowing fork, the chaff, and the grain. Not only does he inspire confidence in them by calling their ministry a mission for the harvest, but he also empowers them to carry out this ministry, according to these words: "He gave them authority over unclean spirits to cast them out and to heal every sickness and every disease."

Look at the opportunity of the mission: he sends them precisely after they saw him raise a dead man, rebuke the sea, and other similar works, and after they received by word and deed a sufficient demonstration of the divinity of Jesus. The Lord sends them first to Judea, as to a school, so that, trained there, they might learn to fight against all nations, and for this reason, he treats them like weak little birds whom the mother excites to fly.

So that the Jews would not think that Jesus hated them for having insulted him and called him possessed by a demon, he took particular care to correct them, forbidding his disciples any other ministry and sending them physicians and doctors. He not only forbade his disciples from proclaiming the Gospel to others before the Jews, but he also did not allow them to travel on the roads leading to the Gentiles, saying, "Do not go among the Gentiles." And although the Samaritans were easier to convert to the Gospel, nevertheless, because they were enemies of the Jews, he did not want the Gospel to be preached to the Samaritans before the Jews. "And you shall not enter," he says, "the cities of the Samaritans."

By separating his disciples from the Samaritans and sending them to the children of Israel, whom he calls sheep that perish and not sheep that separate themselves, the Lord shows us how he used all means to forgive them and draw them back. You see the greatness of the ministry; you see the dignity of the apostles; He does not command them, as He did Moses and the prophets, to announce to us tangible things, but new things beyond human understanding. For those prophets announced the goods of the earth, and these apostles the kingdom of heaven and all the good things contained within it. But after respect for the faith spread everywhere, they were, if indeed they still occurred afterward, fewer and rarer. God usually performs such miracles when evils have reached their full manifestation, because that is when he makes his power known
