“THE LITTLEST MISSION”

Today is the 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time and our first reading is from the Prophet Isaiah. This reading is called the Suffering Servant Prophecy. It amazingly describes the promised Messiah approximately seven hundred years before He is born. It is understandable that the Israelites did not recognize Jesus as their Messiah. Their expectations were for a Savior of military/political strength to free them from their slavery. They did not want a suffering servant such as Isaiah prophesied; “my servant shall justify many, their guilt He shall bear, and through His suffering the will of God shall be accomplished.” Saint Paul writes in his letter to the Hebrews; “Jesus is the Son of God who has been similarly tested in every way but without sin, and He can sympathize with our weaknesses, so let us confidently approach the throne of God to receive His mercy and grace.” God loves you right where you are, with all your flaws and wounds. You are exactly the sinner for whom He gave His life. In our gospel reading we find two Apostles who still do not understand Jesus’s mission, or in fact their own. They wish to be first above the rest. Jesus sets them straight saying; “whoever wishes to be great must become a servant, for the Son of Man did not come to be served but came to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many.” Do you practice Christ’s Littlest Mission? **IT IS IN BECOMING LITTLE.....THAT YOU BECOME GREAT!!!**

TWENTY-NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Isaiah 53:10-11

Isaiah speaks of how the Servant of God will have to give his life up for the sins of other people. Because of this suffering the Servant will receive eternal life for himself and all the people whose sins are forgiven because of him.

Second Reading: Hebrews 4:14-16

Jesus is considered to be the new high priest and mediator between God and his people. Fortunately, Jesus has experienced the same temptations as other people, and so he has more tolerance of our weaknesses.

Gospel: Mark 10:35-45

Two of the disciples ask Jesus that they be allowed to sit at his right and left side when he comes into his glory. Jesus explains that they should not be concerned with their position. Instead they should concern themselves with serving others just as Jesus was planning to serve many in giving his own life for their sins.

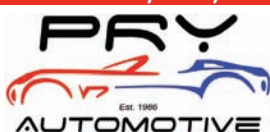
