He has come to the help of his servant Israel for he remembered his promise of mercy, the promise he made to our fathers, to Abraham and his children forever.





"THE CHRIST JOURNEY"

Welcome to the 2nd week of Advent. Today's first reading from the Prophet Isaiah is special because it offers you two prophecies beginning with Isaiah saying, "a shoot shall sprout from the stump and roots of Jesse, from which a bud shall blossom." Jesse was the father of King David, and this is the ancestral line from which Jesus shall be born. Isaiah then continues with his second prophecy saying, "a little child will guide them, and the Spirit of the Lord will rest on Him, the Spirit of Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Strength (fortitude), Piety, and Fear (AWE) of the Lord.' Do you recognize these gifts? They are the Gifts of the Holy Spirit that you received at Your Baptism, and which were then strengthened with your Sacrament of Confirmation. Even before Christ came into the world, God the Father prepared these Gifts for you, in order to make the journey of a lifetime. These gifts help you to SURRENDER ALL to the Lord, exchanging Your WILL for His WILL. In today's Gospel Saint John, the Baptist tells you; "REPENT, the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand, prepare the way for your Lord, and make straight His path, for He will Baptize you with the Fire of the Holy Spirit." DURING THIS ADVENT WHAT WILL YOU FIX IN YOUR LIFE TO MAKE STRAIGHT THE PATH FOR CHRIST? INVITE HIM BY SAYING; "COME LORD JESUS AND CHANGE MY HEART WITH THE FIRE OF YOUR LOVE."
