"JESUS IS CALLING"

Today is the Third Sunday of Ordinary Time. Our first reading is from the Prophet Isaiah, who continues to call God's servants to the work of revealing God's Salvation to all, saying; "the people who walked in darkness have seen a great light for you have brought them abundant Joy and great Rejoicing". What part do you play in spreading Good News? Does your faith journey ever appear in your conversations? Saint Paul reminds us that we should not be divided as Christians. It is not our own opinion we should preach, but only those teachings of Christ, even when difficult. It is what Christ teaches in His Holy Word that matters. Interpretations and opinions are a dime a dozen and everybody has one. Only following Jesus's Word will get you into heaven. Steer clear of false prophets and twisted teachings. In our Gospel today Jesus reiterates the quote from our first reading. He then calls His first four Apostles into His service, saying, "Come after me and I will make you fishers of men." They didn't think it over, they didn't say I'll get back to you in a few years, they didn't have a barrage of questions for the Lord, NO they took a chance and stepped out in FAITH. They dropped everything, leaving their father, boats and their work. 
