“NOTHING GREATER”

Today is the Sixth Sunday of Easter and the first reading is from the Acts of the Apostles. The Apostle Philip is preaching, curing and performing great miracles in Samaria. Peter and John join Philip, and they lay hands on the many believers as they receive the Holy Spirit and there was “great joy in the city.” The Church is quickly increasing in numbers through the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Peter tells you to, “Sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts, as He suffered for sins once, the righteous for the sake of the unrighteous, that He might lead you to God.” Is Christ the Lord of your life, the head of your household or have you allowed the ways of the culture to rule?
