"WHOLEHEARTEDLY....."

In our first reading today, the Lord warns, "Let the scoundrel forsake his wicked ways and thoughts." In our second reading Saint Paul tells you how he has surrendered his life to the Lord and as he sits in prison he writes, "Brothers and sisters; Christ will be magnified in my body, whether in life or in death, for me Christ is life, and death is gain. Conduct yourselves in a way worthy of the Gospel of Christ." Will you take his advice to heart and daily conform your life so that it resembles Jesus? Do those who see you, see Christ in their midst? *This IS your mission.* In today's gospel, Jesus tells you the parable of a landlord who hires workers at different stages of the workday promising them a fair day's wage. At the end of the day the landlord pays them all the same wages, regardless of the number of hours they worked. In our human way of thinking, it seems tremendously unjust. Why should a person who only worked one hour be paid the same as the one who worked all day? The Lord asks, "are you envious because I am generous?" Does the Lord not give His promise equally to all who love and follow Him? The soul, who loves Christ, whether early or late, earns heaven. Do not perceive God's generosity as unfair. You, who spend your life in obedience to God's ways, have been the balm for His wounds. Latecomers grieve their loss of time with the Lord and the error of their ways. The Lord ended today's first reading with, "My thoughts are not your thoughts, nor are your ways my ways, for my thoughts and ways are higher than yours." **TODAY PAUSE FOR A MOMENT AND PONDER GOD'S MYSTERIOUS LOVE FOR YOU, THEN WHOLEHEARTEDLY SAY.....THANK YOU JESUS!**

TWENTY-FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Isaiah 55:6-9

Isaiah expresses an urgent plea that all should seek the Lord and turn to him for mercy.

Second Reading: Philippians 1:20c-24, 27a

In a strongly personal message from Paul while in prison, he says that he wishes "to be freed from this life and to be with Christ," but he realizes that he still has much important work to do.

Gospel: Matthew 20:1-16a

Jesus tells the parable of the owner of an estate who hires workmen for his vineyard. When, at the end of the day, he pays a full day's wage to those who worked only one hour, those who worked all day complained bitterly. But the owner says, "I am free to do as I please, am I not?" Jesus reminds us through this parable that "the last shall be first and the first shall be last."
