

#### **REQUESTING A SPONSOR FORM**

It is a tremendous honor to get asked to be a Sponsor or Godparent. A family feels that you are a good Catholic role model and wants you to take on a vital role in the spiritual development of their child.

In order to be a sponsor, by Canon Law, you must be fully initiated as a Roman Catholic by being Baptized, and received both Communion and Confirmation **and** be an active, practicing Catholic.

Here at St. Therese, we are responsible in verifying that an individual is qualified to be a sponsor.

This can be done by certifying their Sacrament of Confirmation in our archives for those that received their sacrament here at our parish, or by attesting that they are registered & active parishioners.

We can attest that an individual is registered by finding them in our data base. You might be saying to yourself, "I have been coming here for years, I am a member." Ok, but are you registered? When adult children move out of their parent's homes, their registration becomes invalid. They need to register at their local church. If they live locally and continue to attend St. Therese, they would need to fill out a registration form and establish their own identification. If you have adult children still living at home with you, then encourage them to establish their own registration.

What makes you "active"? This means you attend mass regularly and use weekly envelopes. This is not about the money IN the envelope, it is about THE envelope, showing that you are here, attending mass and fulfilling your obligation as an active, practicing Catholic. Did you know that every week, the collections are posted to those corresponding registered families in our database? That is how you are able to receive your End of Year Tax Statements. There is also a special code used for an empty envelope too. Again, it's not what's IN the envelope, it is THE envelope.

Making a donation to the church is a very personal decision and we respect the privacy of those individuals that prefer to give anonymously.

With a congregation this large and priests that rotate serving masses, it is next to impossible to monitor who comes to mass on a regular basis. Think of your envelope, whether an official church envelope or any one you choose to use, as a means of "attendance". You can use an envelope weekly, monthly, or quarterly and your "attendance" will be noted accordingly. This way, when you ask for a sponsor form and your registration is verified, a priest can look and see if you attended church.

This system in place is not perfect and it is not meant to stand in your way of getting a sponsor form. It should be a tool for you to help evaluate your qualifications to be a sponsor. You are about to make a vow in front of God and a parish community that you do fulfil your obligation as a practicing Catholic. Life keeps us busy and sometimes attending mass may not always be a weekly priority, but if you completely dismiss this obligation, how can your church attest to your commitment to be a sponsor?



#### PARISH MEMBERSHIP

Our parish family invites all of its members to participate fully in our spiritual and social life. Every family moving into our parish is requested to register; forms are available in all parish offices and on our website. Registration is required for Religious Education Programs and the reception of the Sacraments. Only active, registered members can receive sponsor forms for baptism or confirmation. New members must wait 3 months before being eligible for a sponsor form. Please contact the Parish Office for more information.

#### **CELEBRATE THE SACRAMENTS**

**BAPTISM** is celebrated on two Saturdays each month at 1:00pm. A parent preparation class is held monthly. Parents please call the Parish Office at least two months in advance. Visit the parish website, <a href="https://www.StThereseRoxbury.org">www.StThereseRoxbury.org</a> for dates and information. Private Baptisms are reserved for Military deployment or extreme extenuating circumstances. **New members need to wait 3 months before scheduling a baptism.** 

**FIRST RECONCILIATION & FIRST COMMUNION**: Our Religious Education program begins with Grade 1. First Reconciliation & First Communion is a 2-year preparation program. Grades 3-8 are required years of continued faith education for entry into our Confirmation program.

**CONFIRMATION**: Our 2-year program begins in the Freshman year of high school and culminates with the sacrament at the end of the Sophomore year of high school.

**MATRIMONY**: Couples should call the Parish Office at least one year in advance. Please do not set your reception date until your church date is definite.

**HOLY ORDERS**- If you think God may be calling you to the serve Him in the ministry of the priesthood, please contact the Diocesan Vocation Office (973) 777-8818 X 711.

**ANOINTING OF THE SICK-** The Rite of Anointing tells us there is no need to wait until a person is at the point of death to receive the Sacrament. A careful judgment about the serious nature of the illness is sufficient. For the SERIOUSLY SICK and dying contact the Rectory immediately.

**RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION (R.C.I.A.)** Preparation for the sacraments begins in September and culminates at the Easter Vigil.

MINISTRY TO THE SICK & ELDERLY: For the confined, the elderly and/or shut-in, be they at home or in the hospital, please inform the Rectory. Holy Communion will be brought to the home of any person permanently or temporarily homebound.

**CONSECRATED LIFE:** Those called to consecrated life are invited to follow Christ more closely through the total offering of their entire life to God through the vows of chastity, poverty and obedience. For more information, contact Chancellor / Delegate for Religious (973) 777-8818 X 247.

#### **UPDATING FAMILY REGISTRATIONS**

Do you have an adult child that no longer lives at home? If they no longer live at home but they live locally, have they <u>re-registered</u> at St. Therese at their new address? Have they moved away? Encourage them to register at their local church, because their St. Therese registration becomes inactive when they move away. Most parishes, including St. Therese, require sponsors for Baptism, Confirmation or RCIA to be an active, registered member of a parish. It is so important for young adults to establish their own membership. Sacramental information is always kept on record at the Parish. Registration forms are available on the parish website. Please feel free to call the Parish Office with any questions!!
