GOD SO LOVED THE WORLD...

Mary Magdalene came to the tomb while it was still dark. But the darkness was soon overcome with light. Maybe that's the message you need to hear this day. Perhaps for whatever reason you are in darkness right now. Family concerns. Problems at work. Anxiety about your health and your future. The loss of someone you love. Easter promises us more than the starts in our darkness. Easter promises us that in the midst of our deepest darkness the Son rises to overwhelm the darkness forever.

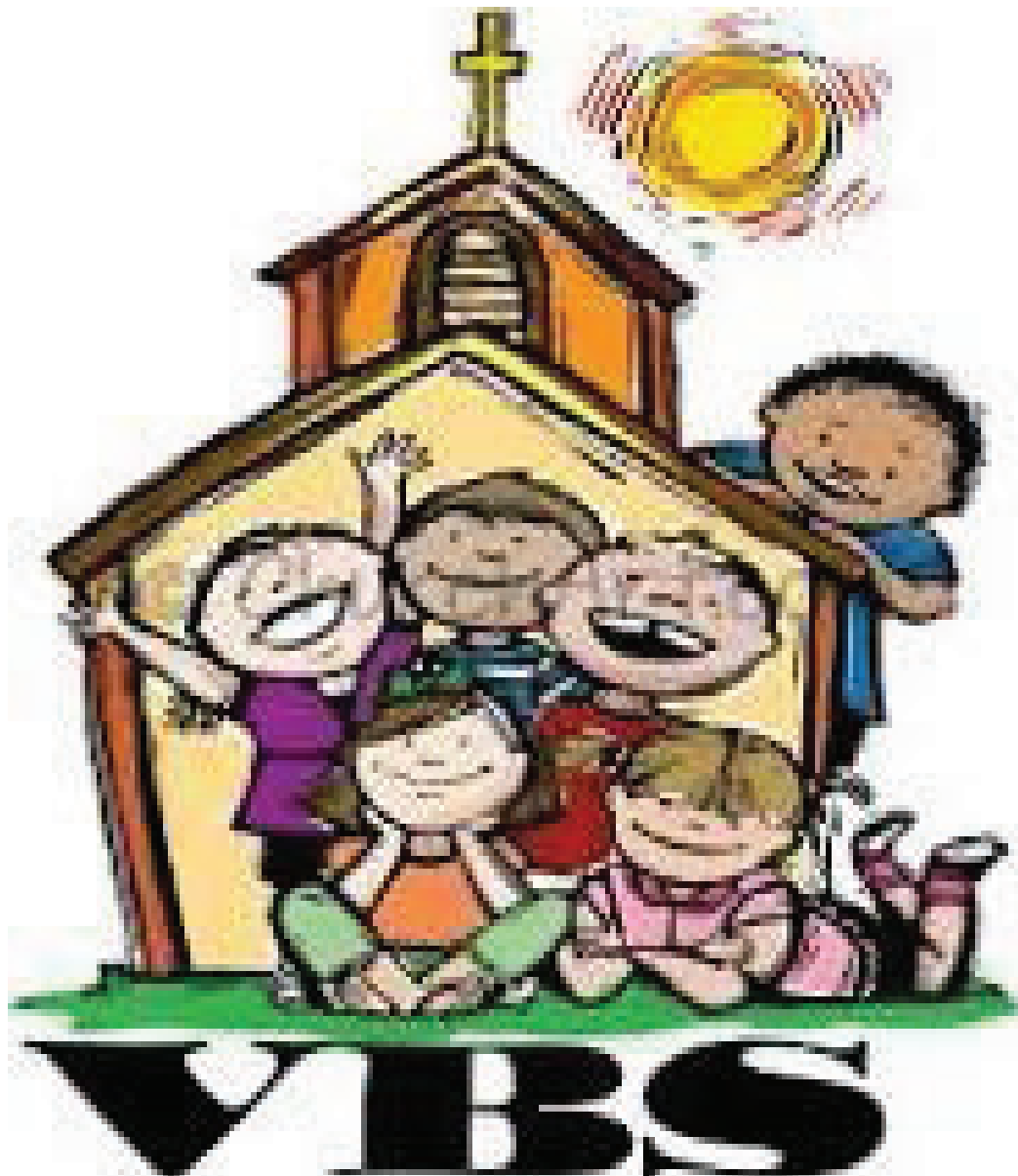
