## WELCOME

We, the Missionary Sisters of St. Charles Borromeo, would like to express our sincere gratitude to Fr. The Regional Catechetical Office for Central and Southern Westchester and Yonkers is now located in the Convent. It is an honor for the Parish to have an Office of the Archdiocese just next door, where Sr. Zeli is the Director of the Office.

Sr. Teolide attended Nursing School in Illinois and is a Registered Nurse. She worked in Chicago and Maryland. She visits the sick and does companionship to the elderly. She also helps Sr. Zeli with the works of the Office. Sr. Zeli holds a Master's Degree in Education from Brazil, a Bachelor's Degree in Science and a Master Degree of Science in Education from St. John's University, and a Master's Degree in Religious Studies from St. Joseph Seminary in Dunwoodie. ## WHO ARE WE?

The Congregation of the Missionary Sisters of St. Charles Borromeo-Scalabrinians was founded by Blessed John Baptist Scalabrini in Piacenza on October 25, 1895, with Father Joseph and Mother Assunta Marchetti as co-founders. Its mission is the evangelical, missionary service to the poorest and those most in need. It spread initially in Brazil, and later to Europe (1936), North America (1941), and in recent decades to various countries in Latin America, Asia and Africa, so that today it is present in 27 countries, with 800 Sisters and 159 communities. The General Headquarters are in Rome. The Sisters live their lives for Jesus Christ according to the demands of the Scalabrinian charism, practicing fraternal life in community as a vital element of religious consecration, and strengthening their fidelity to their vocation through prayer, meditation on the Word of God, and the Eucharistic Celebration, source of communion with God and their brothers and sisters. As their Congregation has developed within history, the Scalabrinian Missionary Sisters have dedicated themselves-and still do-to education, social and pastoral activities, the pastoral care of health, catechesis, evangelization, and collaboration with local churches to assist in the ministry of the Church in caring for the poor.

By living the Scalabrinian charism, Scalabrinian Sisters welcome God's love as a gift to be passed on to those suffering the hardship of being poor. In this way they guarantee the continuation of the prophetic intuition of the Congregation's Founder, John Baptist Scalabrini, who translated this intuition into a practical socio-pastoral project, entrusting its early steps in history to the generous determination of the Cofounders, Father Joseph Marchetti and Mother Assunta Marchetti. The charism of the MSCS Sisters arose at the time of the great Italian emigration toward the Americas at the end of the 19<sup>th</sup> century, as a response of faith that took practical shape as an institution. It continues with the spiritual heirs of Blessed Scalabrini: \*Missionaries of St. Charles, the \*Missionary Sisters of St. Charles Borromeo-Now for all nationalities, and cultures.
