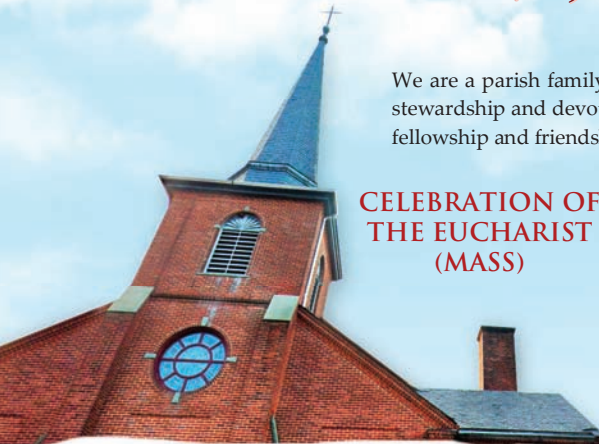

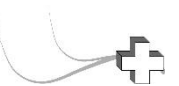

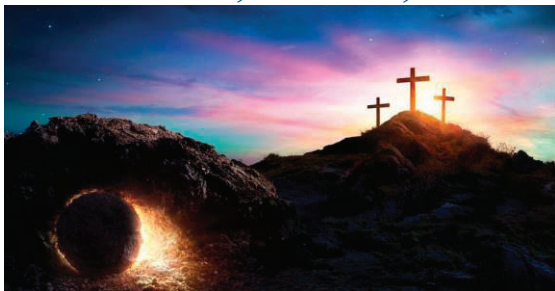

Please join us on **Tuesday, March 17th at 7:00pm** as we embark on our **13 Tuesdays Devotion to Saint Anthony.**

In 1231, Saint Anthony was like a modern-day celebrity. Thousands of faithful would travel miles to hear him preach. He eventually became known as a worker of miracles as the blind regained their sight, the deaf their hearing, and the lame the use of their limbs.

Our devotion will begin on **Tuesday, March 17th and continue for 13 weeks through Tuesday, June 9th.** We will include prayers, hymns, benediction, a short homily featuring the life of this beloved saint, and the distribution of blessed bread to commemorate his dedication to the poor.
