#### Reflection by Sr. Marita

Today we rejoice in the gift of the Holy Spirit poured out to enable us to live as followers of Christ. The beautiful Pentecost Sequence that is part of today's liturgy describes the action of the Holy Spirit in our lives. The Spirit enlightens and refreshes, dissolves what divides us, animates, comforts, consoles, brings harmony and peace. The Spirit's creative activity causes life to spring up within us, healing, guiding, strengthening and renewing us, melting our hardness of heart and refashioning us into God's likeness. We need to be open and receptive to the inflow of the Spirit so that our habitual ways of thinking and acting can be changed, enabling us to see all of life through the lens of the gospel.

The lines of the poem, *To Live With The Spirit*, by Jessica Powers, illustrate that to catch the stirrings of the Spirit we need to be people who listen and who love. Her poem gifts us with insight into the stillness, waiting, listening, faith and trust that draw us into the mystery of God's presence and peace.

"To live with the Spirit of God is to be a listener. It is to keep the vigil of mystery, earthless and still.

One leans to catch the stirring of the Spirit, strange as the wind's will.

The soul that walks where the wind of the Spirit blows

turns like a wandering weather-vane toward love. It may lament like Job or Jeremiah, echo the wounded hart, the mateless dove. It may rejoice in spaciousness of meadow that emulates the freedom of the sky. Always it walks in waylessness, unknowing; it has cast down forever from its hand the compass of the whither and the why.

To live with the Spirit of God is to be a lover. It is becoming love, and like to Him toward Whom we strain with metaphors of creatures:

fire-sweep and water-rush and the wind's whim. The soul is all activity, all silence; and though it surges Godward to its goal, it holds, as moving earth holds sleeping noonday, the peace that is the listening of the soul."

#### **Social Justice Corner**

Father Louis Vitale OFM, was born 90 years ago this week (June 1, 1932) in San Gabriel, California. He is a Franciscan priest, activist, and a co-founder of Nevada Desert Experience. He has engaged in civil disobedience for nearly four decades in pursuit of peace and justice, and has been arrested more than 400 times. Father Vitale says that St. Francis, Gandhi and Martin Luther King, Jr., provide him with inspiration. He met Dr. King in Chicago in 1964.

King's focus on nonviolence left a lasting mark on Father Vitale's strategy as a spiritual leader and reformer. "I had a great admiration for him. When he fasted, I would fast. I was quite involved with those strikes in Chicago," Father Vitale says. Father Vitale would go on to march alongside Cesar Chavez and Dolores Huerta, co-founders of the National Farm Workers Association and advocates of farm workers' rights in the late 1960s. Huerta remained a close friend, sending Vitale letters of encouragement and visiting him in prison.

In 1981, Father Vitale received a letter from Rome asking Franciscans to do something creative in 1982 to honor the 800th anniversary of the birth of St. Francis. Vitale took this to heart. The First Nevada Lenten Experience was held at the Nevada test site, a series of witness and protest actions held at the atomic bomb test site near Las Vegas, Nevada. This was the precursor to the Nevada Desert Experience

Father Louis Vitale was one of the founders of Pace e Bene, a nonviolence service, in 1989. The name means *Peace and all good*. Pace e bene developed educational programs for nonviolent living with an emphasis on spirituality. The programs were designed to encourage: the discovery, internalization and use of the power of nonviolence for personal and social change.

Father Vitale has also been involved in trying to raise awareness about issues of torture.

#### **Basketball Offensive Skills and Shooting Clinic**



#### Reflexión de Sr. Marita

El Espíritu ilumina y refresca, disuelve lo que nos divide, anima, consuela, trae armonía y paz. La actividad creativa del Espíritu hace que la vida brote dentro de nosotros, sanándonos, guiándonos, fortaleciéndonos y renovándonos, derritiendo nuestra dureza de corazón y remodelándonos a la semejanza de Dios. Necesitamos ser abiertos y receptivos a la afluencia del Espíritu para que nuestras formas habituales de pensar y actuar puedan cambiar, permitiéndonos ver toda la vida a través de la lente del evangelio.

El alma que camina donde sopla el viento del Espíritu se vuelve como una veleta errante hacia el amor. Puede lamentarse como Job o Jeremías, haz eco del ciervo herido, la paloma sin pareja. Puede regocijarse en la amplitud del prado que emula la libertad del cielo. Siempre camina sin sentido, sin saberlo; Se ha derribado para siempre de su mano La brújula de dónde y el porqué.


