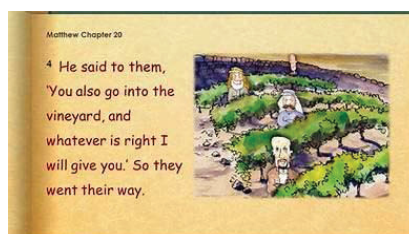

Reflection from Sr. Michealene....

The Lord is near to all who call upon him. Psalm 145

When writing this column for the parish bulletin, I usually take a look at the Sunday readings to see if there is a theme that runs through the liturgy. Today, there seem to be several.

In the first reading, we hear about a “God who is generous in forgiving... whose thoughts are above our thoughts.” In the second, “Conduct yourselves in a way worthy of the gospel of Christ.” In the Alleluia verse, “Open our hearts, Lord, to listen to the words of your Son.” And in the Gospel, a final word – “Are you envious because I am generous?”

That final word, unlike the other phrases, is quite a challenge! If I had been working in the fields in the heat of the day, all day, and people who had begun to work in the last hours of the day, received as much as I had received, I think I would have grumbled too! Of course, if they hadn't been working along with me, I would have had a longer day and still earned the same amount of money. That's one way of looking at it. But that isn't Jesus' point and I don't want it to be mine! I'm not happy being envious of Jesus' generosity, especially when I'm aware of the needs of others and appreciate their hard work.

I'd like to have an open, listening heart that would be in tune with the heart of Jesus... I think that kind of heart comes from being attentive and really hearing the words of Jesus. It comes from hearing these words, not as words written in the pages of some book, but as words addressed to me – to all people who draw near, who listen and who walk in the way of the loving Jesus.

XXV domingo del tiempo ordinario

Reflexión de la hermana Michaelene...

El Señor está cerca de todos los que lo invocan.

Salmo 145

Cuando escribo esta columna para el boletín parroquial, suelo echar un vistazo a las lecturas dominicales para ver si hay un tema que recorra toda la liturgia. Hoy parece haber varios. En la primera lectura, escuchamos acerca de un «Dios generoso en el perdón... cuyos pensamientos están por encima de los nuestros».

En la segunda: «Condúzcanse de manera digna del evangelio de Cristo». En el versículo del Aleluya: «Abre nuestros corazones, Señor, para escuchar las palabras de tu Hijo». Y en el Evangelio, una última palabra: «¿Tienen envidia porque soy generoso?». ¡Esa última frase, a diferencia de las demás, es todo un desafío! Si yo hubiera estado trabajando en el campo bajo el calor del día, todo el día, y las personas que habían comenzado a trabajar en las últimas horas del día recibieran tanto como yo, ¡creo que yo también me habría quejado! Claro, si ellos no hubieran estado trabajando conmigo, yo habría tenido un día más largo y aún así habría ganado la misma cantidad de dinero. Esa es una forma de verlo. ¡Pero ese no es el punto de Jesús y no quiero que sea el mío! No me gusta sentir envidia de la generosidad de Jesús, especialmente cuando soy consciente de las necesidades de los demás y valoro su arduo trabajo. Me gustaría tener un corazón abierto y dispuesto a escuchar, que esté en sintonía con el corazón de Jesús... Creo que ese tipo de corazón surge de estar atento y escuchar de verdad las palabras de Jesús. Surge de escuchar estas palabras, no como palabras escritas en las páginas de algún libro, sino como palabras dirigidas a mí —a todas las personas que se acercan, que escuchan y que caminan por el camino del Jesús amoroso.

Invitamos a todos aquellos que deseen conocer mejor la fe católica y prepararse para recibir los sacramentos a formar parte de este nuevo año de RICA.



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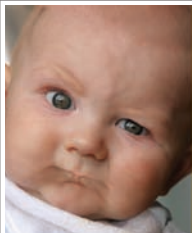
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
