Pastor's Corner
The Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

“The Fourth Commandment has us honor our father and mother, and all who receive authority from God for the good of society. Those in authority also have certain duties.” (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 2197).

Can you believe it has been just over a month since we celebrated Christmas? By now, our decorations are likely back in their boxes and the warm glow of the holidays has faded, but let us not forget that our greatest Christmas gift ever – the Son of God – remains with us always. Even on an ordinary day in Ordinary Time in the middle of winter, He is with us as we gather to celebrate the meal He left us before He died. Let us give thanks as we receive Him once again in the Eucharist.

Moses told the people that one day God would send a prophet from among the descendants who would speak God's word with authority. We believe that this promise is fulfilled in Jesus, who in today's Gospel, speaks God's words with such authority that even the unclean spirits obey Him. We may be anxious about many things, to use Saint Paul's words, but let the knowledge that God can dispel the darkness in our lives give us hope.

Catholic Schools Week

Catholic schools throughout the Diocese of Paterson will celebrate National Catholic Schools Week from January 28th to February 3rd. Our Diocesan schools partner with parents in the faith formation of their children and offer academic excellence.

We are lucky to participate in All Saints Academy, our regional school supported by the parishes of St. Peter the Apostle, St. Ann Church, St. Christopher Church, and St. Pius X Church in Montville. Here is some general information about Catholic schools in the Diocese of Paterson. Over five thousand students are enrolled in our fifteen Catholic elementary schools and three Diocesan high schools (and four private Catholic high schools). Our elementary and secondary standardized test scores are above national averages. Ninety-nine percent of our diocesan high school students were accepted into college in Spring 2023. Over \$96M in total college scholarships were awarded to diocesan high school graduates this past (2022/23) school year. Please pray for our Catholic schools.

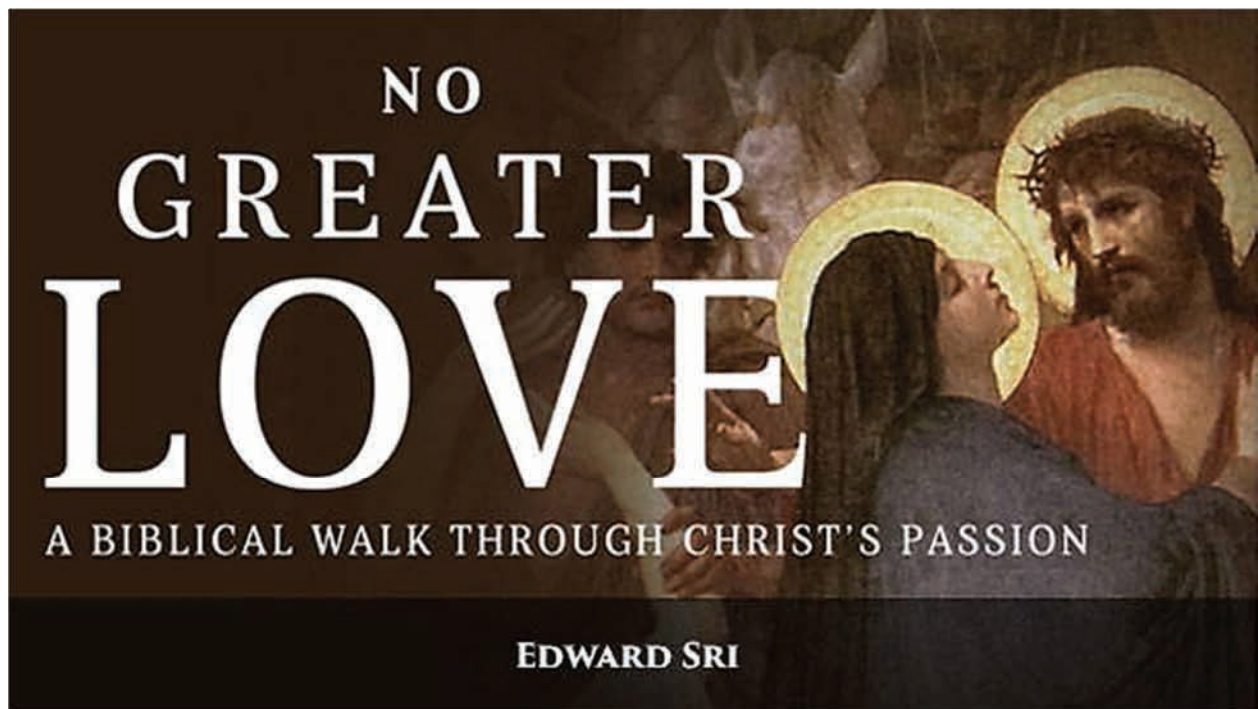
