

Pastor's Corner
Easter Sunday of the Resurrection of the Lord

“Easter does not eliminate the cross but defeats it in the miraculous duel that changed our human history. Even our time, marked by so many crosses, invokes the dawn of paschal hope. Christ’s resurrection is not an idea, a theory, but the event that is the foundation of faith. He, the Risen One, through the Holy Spirit, continues to remind us of this, so that we can be His witnesses even where human history does not see light on the horizon. Paschal hope does not disappoint.” (Pope Leo XIV, Catechesis: Easter as a Compass in Daily Life, November 5, 2025).

Alleluia! With joy and gratitude, we praise God, who raised Jesus from the dead to new life in the eternal kingdom. Truly, this is the day the Lord has made, for in His sacrifice on the cross He conquered sin and death, and in His Resurrection, He has opened the door to our salvation. Let us rejoice! Let us be glad! Gathered this weekend to celebrate the Eucharistic banquet, let us join with all the saints and angels to sing in praise and thanksgiving to our God.

Overview of Easter Time

Like Christmas, Easter has its own season that lasts long beyond the day itself. The focus of all we do as a parish community and as individuals during Easter Time is meant to be filled with the joy and glory of the Resurrection: from the sacramental celebrations of Baptism, Confirmation, and First Holy Communion, “Alleluia” should resound from the rafters of the church and in the depths of our souls. Easter Time is also the period of mystagogy for the neophytes, those newly initiated into the Church. During this time, they are instructed more deeply in the mysteries of the Church, particularly the sacraments.

Annual Retreat

I usually take my annual retreat at the end of May. This May, we have a super busy parish schedule including Confirmation, First Holy Communion, and three weddings. Therefore, I am taking my annual retreat starting the day after Easter, April 6th, and returning on Friday, April 10. As is my tradition, I will spend the week with the Passionist Community at their Our Lady of Florida Spiritual Center in North Palm Beach. My flight to Palm Beach International Airport is scheduled to land at 11:00 a.m. so, weather permitting, I will head north and spend some time on the beach in Jupiter Beach before reporting to the retreat center.

While I will spend most of my time in prayer and reflection (and maybe a nap or two), on Tuesday night I will head down to Boynton Beach to eat dinner with my Godmother Grace and my Godfather Sal. My Aunt Grace and Uncle Sal recently celebrated their 70th wedding anniversary. What a milestone and what an inspiration!

I leave the parish in the capable hands of Fr. Jose and Fr. Chris Muldoon. I look forward to returning to St. Peter’s refreshed and recharged. Please keep me in your prayers during my Easter Week retreat as I will include St. Peter’s in my prayers.

Domingo de Pascua

«La Pascua no elimina la cruz, sino que la derrota en el duelo milagroso que cambió nuestra historia humana. Incluso nuestro tiempo, marcado por tantas cruces, invoca el amanecer de la esperanza pascual. La resurrección de Cristo no es una idea, una teoría, sino el acontecimiento que constituye el fundamento de la fe. Él, el Resucitado, por medio del Espíritu Santo, continúa recordándonos esto, para que podamos ser sus testigos incluso allí donde la historia humana no vislumbra luz en el horizonte. La esperanza pascual no defrauda». (Papa León XIV, Catequesis: *La Pascua como brújula en la vida cotidiana*, 5 de noviembre de 2025).

Reunidos este fin de semana para celebrar el banquete eucarístico, unámonos a todos los santos y ángeles para cantar alabanzas y acciones de gracias a nuestro Dios.

Resumen del Tiempo Pascual

Al igual que la Navidad, la Pascua tiene su propio tiempo litúrgico, el cual se extiende mucho más allá del día mismo de la fiesta. El centro de todo cuanto realizamos, tanto como comunidad parroquial como a nivel individual, durante el Tiempo Pascual, debe estar impregnado de la alegría y la gloria de la Resurrección: desde las celebraciones sacramentales del Bautismo, la Confirmación y la Primera Comunión, el «Aleluya» debe resonar desde las bóvedas de la iglesia y en lo más profundo de nuestras almas. El Tiempo Pascual es también el periodo de mistagogía para los neófitos: aquellos que han sido iniciados recientemente en la Iglesia. Durante este tiempo, reciben una instrucción más profunda sobre los misterios de la Iglesia, particularmente sobre los sacramentos.






