From the Pastor
2nd Sunday of Advent - A
December 7, 2025

IS THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION IN THE BIBLE? **Monday** is the **Patronal Feast Day** of the **USA** and the **Archdiocese of Newark**; the **Immaculate Conception of the BVM**. After recent confusion, **Rome** ruled it is **always** a **holy day of obligation** in

the **USA**, even when it falls on a **Saturday** or **Monday** or, like last year, when it was on a **Sunday** and was transferred to **Monday**. Even more confusing to many is what it celebrates and where its biblical foundation is found.

As **Jesus** said at the **Last Supper**: **"I have much more to tell you, but you cannot bear it now. When he comes, the Spirit of truth, he will guide you to all truth."** [John 16:12-13] Under the **Holy Spirit's** guidance, the **Church** pieces together what **Scripture** reveals about our **Blessed Mother**. On the **Immaculate Conception**, the **Gospel** is the **Annunciation**, when she conceived **Jesus**, so some erroneously believe her pregnancy with **Jesus** was for only 17 days - but we celebrate that day on **March 25**, 9 months before **Christmas**. That **Gospel** was chosen because it contains the first 'clue' to HER unique conception in the womb of her mother, **Saint Anne**; we mark **Mary's birth** 9 months from today: **September 8**. Anyway ...

Even before she accepted - or was even offered the honor - of being **Christ's Mother**, the **Angel** had already called her, **"full of grace."** [Luke 21:28] - which suggests she was **already in** a state of sinlessness. And as the **Ark of the Covenant**, in which the **Ten Commandments** - **God's word in stone** - resided - had to be made of **"pure gold"** [cf. Exodus 25] or without any impurities or imperfections, so did the **New Ark of the Covenant**, in whose womb **God's Word made flesh, Jesus Christ**, resided. However, I recently came across another biblical reference which also attests to her being sinless:

"Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ loved the church and handed himself over for her to sanctify her, cleansing her by the bath of water with the word, that he might present to himself the church in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish." [Ephesians 5:25-27]

While we tend to read that as a passage about **marriage**, **Saint Paul** ends his eye-raising quips like **"Wives should be subordinate to their husbands"** [5:22] by admitting, **"This is a great mystery, but I speak in reference to Christ and the church."** [5:32] So, since the **Blessed Virgin Mary** is **God's Bride** in a super special and unique way, would **God** not have sanctified her, purified her ... made her to be without spot or wrinkle or any blemish from the start, as He made **Adam** and **Eve**, so that He could present her to Himself in splendor? No wonder, since the **Church's** earliest centuries, she has been called **'The New Eve.'**

That answers **WHY God** enabled her to be conceived without the stain of **Original Sin**, here is **HOW God** did it. Since our all-knowing **God** is **not** limited by **time** or **space**, He gave her this special privilege **IN ANTICIPATION** of her **Son's** redemptive work. Since **Jesus** redeemed His **Mother**, she is **NOT** a **'Co-Redemptrix.'** Since she always cooperated **WITH Jesus** and was His companion from His **Conception, Nativity, Infancy, Childhood**, during His **Ministry**, even to the **Foot of the Cross** and His **Tomb**, she is the ideal disciple and role model. And by reflecting on the **20 Mysteries of the Rosary**, we become **secondhand** witnesses to what she experienced, in most **Mysteries**, on a firsthand basis!

She uniquely received: a 'double dose, if you will, of **God's** gift of **sanctifying grace**, which enabled her to reject all sin. Some liken it to a 'holy vaccine' which protected her from all damage caused by sin. This, in turn, equipped her with the spiritual graces that made her a fit **Mother** for the **Redeemer** and for the **Church**. We receive a similar, yet far lesser dose of all this through the **Sacraments**: **Baptism** washes **Original Sin** away; **Penance** restores us to grace; the **Eucharist, Confirmation, Anointing of the Sick, Matrimony** and **Ordination** fuel us with the graces needed to live out whatever **God** has called us to be.

What a joy to know that - in all this - our Blessed **Mother** is also watching over and interceding for us! **O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to you!** See you at **holy Mass** on **Monday** ... and remember to **wear something blue** in honor of the **Immaculate Conception**.
