To celebrate our *semiquincentennial* or *'half of five hundred years'* - the *250<sup>th</sup> Anniversary* of the signing of the *Declaration of Independence*, the *United States Conference of Catholic Bishops [USCCB]* consecrated our *Country* last *Friday*, the *Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus*. In part three of my series on this historic event, I offer selections from the *Prayer Service* provided by the *USCCB* so that each one of us may unite in prayer for our *Country*.

Ideally, before an image of the *Sacred Heart of Jesus and an American Flag*, between now and the *Fourth of July*, all should offer these prayers, alone or with others. For one thing I believe - I HOPE - we can all agree on is: our *Country*, our *World*, and our *Church* need PRAYER!

### *Introduction*

As we celebrate the *Consecration* of the *United States of America* to the *Most Sacred Heart of Jesus*, may we strive to imitate the love and mercy which *Christ* has made known to us through His *Most Sacred Heart*. As we bow before the *God* of every nation, may we recall that *Christ*, in His own *Blood*, has removed all divisions and out of the many nations created the *One People of God*. As we venerate the *Sacred Heart*, let us reflect that we ourselves are *Christ's* disciples and must therefore follow Him, loving not with stony hearts, but with living hearts. May we pray with all our hearts, so we may grasp the mystery of *Christ's* love more clearly and experience its power more deeply.

### *Opening Prayer*

Let us pray. Clothe us, *Lord God*, with the virtues of the *Heart* of your *Son* and set us aflame with His love, that, conformed to His image, we may merit a share in eternal redemption. Through our *Lord Jesus Christ*, your *Son*, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the *Holy Spirit, God*, for ever and ever. *Amen*.

### *Prayer of Consecration of our Country To the Sacred Heart of Jesus*

#### *O Most Sacred Heart of Jesus:*

You know the longings of our hearts, and you desire that we enjoy friendship with you. From your pierced side, you have poured out the wellspring of life, for which we thirst. Your heart burns with a love for all people to return to a right relationship with you.

We celebrate the abundant gifts you have given this nation, founded on the self-evident truths that our *Creator* has endowed all people with the right to life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness.

We make reparation for the offenses against you and against human dignity that have taken place in this nation.

May our hearts be united to yours, so that our families and communities enjoy peace and happiness; may broken relationships be reconciled, injustices repaired, and the wounds of our land be healed.

May your holy *Catholic Church* serve as a sign, pointing all people to your infinite love.

O *Desire of Nations* and *Center of History*, we ask you to bless these *United States of America*.

Who live and reign with *God* the *Father* in the unity of the *Holy Spirit, God*, for ever and ever. *Amen*.

The *Prayer Service* may conclude with the singing of *'God Bless America'* or another patriotic song. Next week: the special *Intercessions* that were composed for this historic event; may our individual offering of them make us 'one in prayer' for the USA.

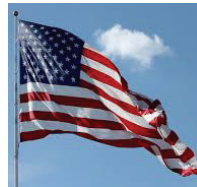
FATHER'S DAY REMEMBRANCE



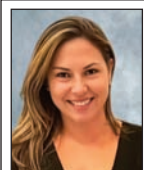
