Dear parishioners,

It is a real joy for me to introduce myself to you this weekend as your new Pastor!

I look forward to our journey in faith together as brothers and sisters in Christ. I come to you after having served almost seven years as the Vicar for Clergy in the Newark Archdiocese. A key part of that role was guiding the process of recommending to our Archbishop, Cardinal Joseph Tobin, the assignment of priests throughout the archdiocese – particularly pastors. So it was a surprise – a very pleasant one! – when he bypassed my recommendations for St. Mary’s to instead tell me he would like to send me here. I joyfully accepted. And the joy was increased when he also decided to send a newly ordained priest to serve here alongside me, Fr. Konrad Kosiek.

Some of you may know I am not a complete stranger to this parish. On various occasions when Fr. Mike was not available over the past few years, I was one of the priests asked to come celebrate daily Masses for you, several funeral Masses, and even a couple of weekend Masses. I think that helps me feel already at home. I thank Fr. Mike for his many years of service here, and for meeting with me recently to help me get acclimated.

As you and I live and pray and serve together in the coming years, we will get to know each other. But I thought I’d share a little about myself through this letter to you. I grew up in Bergen County, in the town of Waldwick. Our family belonged to the parish of St. Luke’s in Hohokus, where I was very active in our parish youth group. I am the oldest of eight children. My parents are retired, and living in Allentown, Pennsylvania, where this weekend our family has been gathering to celebrate my dad’s 87<sup>th</sup> birthday.

I also have eleven nieces and nephews, two great-nephews and one great-niece.

After graduating from Waldwick High School I attended the Honors Tutorial College of Ohio University in Athens, Ohio, where I graduated with a degree in journalism. (I have always loved to read and write!). I began thinking about priesthood during my senior of college, and worked as a print journalist for two years after graduation while I discerned whether God was calling me to priesthood.

I was ordained a priest in 1992 after graduating from Immaculate Conception Seminary, Seton Hall University. I was parochial vicar at Annunciation, Paramus (1992-1998), parochial vicar at Little Flower, Berkeley Heights (1998-2003), Pastor of Guardian Angel, Allendale (2003-2019) and Vicar for Clergy (2019-2026). While in residence at St. Thomas the Apostle, Bloomfield, these past seven years, I have been a regular weekend assistant at parishes including St. Mary, Closter; St. Luke, Hohokus; and St. Gabriel the Archangel, Saddle River. Since 2002 I have also served as an adjunct professor of Homiletics at our seminary.

I am enthusiastic about this next chapter in my priestly life and being part of this parish and community. In the collect (opening prayer) for Mass this weekend, we ask God to “fill your faithful with holy joy.” May we always seek that and may it shape our life as brothers and sisters in the Lord.

Praised be Jesus Christ!

My name is Father Konrad Kosiek, and I was ordained a priest of Jesus Christ on May 23, just over a month ago. I am 27 years old and was born and raised in New Jersey. My parents immigrated from Poland, and I was blessed to grow up in a deeply Catholic home. I thank God every day for the gift of their faith and for teaching me the Polish language and culture. I am the second oldest of six children, and my family has always been one of the greatest blessings in my life!

My vocation to the priesthood began at the age of eight when I became an altar server at my home parish, St. Theresa of the Child Jesus in Linden. Even then, I used to tell people that when I grew up I wanted to be either a priest or a soccer player! After graduating from high school, I attended Seton Hall University to study Biology with the goal of becoming a physical therapist. After three years, however, I felt the Lord calling me more clearly to the priesthood and entered Immaculate Conception Seminary, also at Seton Hall. Seven years later, by God's grace, I was ordained a priest.

I am truly grateful and excited to begin my first parish assignment here at St. Mary's. I have always had a deep love for our Blessed Mother, and I firmly believe that the Lord has brought me to this parish so that I may serve under her maternal care and protection. My greatest desire as a priest is to help others encounter Jesus Christ more deeply through the sacraments, prayer, and the life of the Church.

Outside of parish ministry, I enjoy playing soccer and tennis, running, reading, and spending time with family and friends. I also have a special love for working with young people, having encountered the Lord in a profound way through my own parish youth group.

I look forward to celebrating the Holy Mass with you, hearing Confessions, administering the sacraments, and getting to know you over the months and years ahead. Please know that I have already begun praying for all of you, and I humbly ask you to keep me in your prayers as well.

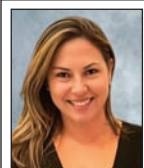
