## AN EASTER GREETING FR. MARTIN

We have all experienced the awesome beauty of stained glass windows that illuminate the great churches of our world.

The most beautiful stained glass windows are those in which the chemicals creating the various colors are added to the sand during the melting process to form the glass.

To become a window, each single pane of colored glass must first be broken. The window is created not by a single pane of glass but by joining broken pieces of glass with strips of lead to other broken pieces of different colors. The final effect is left to God: It is only when the light of the sun passes through the broken pieces of glass that the color and the shapes work their magic.

This Easter is the celebration of God's great promise that in our own experience of brokenness we rise to new life of color and beauty and wholeness in the eternal light of the resurrection. Christ our light illuminates our pieced-together lives with his light of compassion, love, forgiveness and reconciliation.

In the miracle of Easter the life and love of our God melts together within our hearts like the color of the stained glass, illuminating every moment of our lives with the color of Easter hope.

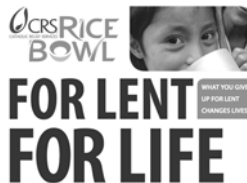

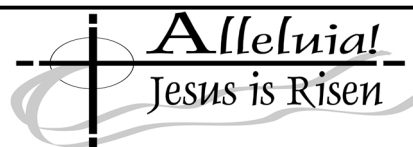
