

REFLECTION ON TODAY'S READINGS

Today's readings provide clear and inspiring reminders of the most fundamental aspect of our identity — that of servants of our most high and holy God, His modern-day disciples, and stewards.

John the Baptist recognized the holiness of Jesus and the response due to Him when he encountered Christ in person on the day they met at the Jordan River. His response, which we read in our Gospel passage from St. John was, "Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world... He is the one of whom I said, 'A man is coming after me who ranks ahead of me because he existed before me.'"

What a powerful description of our Lord and the place He should rightfully have in each of our lives. He is truly our Savior, the only one who can free us from our sinfulness. We are utterly and completely dependent on His power, love, and mercy. Therefore, He truly does "rank ahead" of us; he deserves to be first, above all other priorities and plans in our lives. Let us examine our daily lives and encourage our children to do the same.

Does the way I spend my time reflect that God comes first?

† Do prayer and weekly Mass, regular confession, and time with my family "rank ahead" of everything else on my calendar?

† Do I use my talents, skills, and energy to serve my family, parish and community in thanksgiving and recognition that God's kingdom ranks ahead of any other goals or ambitions?

† Do I spend my money and use my material possessions to glorify God?

Challenge questions, to be sure. But questions worthy of our high calling as Christian stewards offered a glorious mission in service of our Lord and His kingdom. What will our response be?

Las lecturas de hoy nos ofrecen recordatorios claros e inspiradores del aspecto más fundamental de nuestra identidad: la de siervos de nuestro Dios altísimo y santo, sus discípulos de hoy y administradores de sus dones.

Juan el Bautista reconoció la santidad de Jesús y la reverencia que se le debía cuando se encontró con Cristo en persona el día que se conocieron en el río Jordán. Su respuesta, que leemos en el pasaje del Evangelio de San Juan, fue: «He aquí el Cordero de Dios, que quita el pecado del mundo... Este es de quien yo dije: "Después de mí viene un hombre que es anterior a mí, porque ya existía antes que yo"».



¡Qué descripción tan poderosa de nuestro Señor y del lugar que legítimamente debe ocupar en la vida de cada uno de nosotros! Él es verdaderamente nuestro Salvador, el único que puede liberarnos de nuestros pecados. Dependemos total y completamente de su poder, amor y misericordia. Por lo tanto, Él verdaderamente está «por encima» de nosotros; merece ser el primero, por encima

de todas las demás prioridades y planes en nuestras vidas. Examinemos nuestra vida diaria y animemos a nuestros hijos a hacer lo mismo.

¿Refleja la forma en que uso mi tiempo que Dios es lo primero?

† ¿La oración y la Misa semanal, la confesión regular y el tiempo con mi familia tienen prioridad sobre todo lo demás en mi agenda?

† ¿Utilizo mis talentos, habilidades y energía para servir a mi familia, parroquia y comunidad en acción de gracias y reconociendo que el reino de Dios tiene prioridad sobre cualquier otra meta o ambición?

† ¿Gasto mi dinero y uso mis bienes materiales para glorificar a Dios?

Preguntas desafiantes, sin duda. Pero preguntas dignas de nuestro alto llamado como siervos cristianos, a quienes se nos ha confiado una gloriosa misión al servicio de nuestro Señor y su reino. ¿Cuál será nuestra respuesta?






