

WELCOME VISITORS & GUESTS

BAPTISMS: Families wishing to schedule a baptism, must be registered members of the parish. Baptisms are generally scheduled three months out from the time of registration.

WEDDINGS: Couples wishing to get married should be registered at Our Lady. They must schedule a meeting with a priest or deacon before setting a date.



SPONSOR LETTERS

Sponsor Letters are for Godparents or Sponsors of those receiving the Sacrament of Baptism or Confirmation. Anyone who needs a Letter of Eligibility or Sponsor Letter must be a **registered and participating** parishioner for at least **three (3) months**. If you are over 21 years of age you must register as your own person, you should not be under your parents' account.

All requests go through the Parish Office. Once received & processed, the Pastor will sign off and the sponsor/Godparent will pick-up the letter directly from the Pastor—Fr. Marty. **The process may take up to 2 weeks.**
