

EASTER SUNDAY OF THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD



Today we begin the Easter Season. Our Gospel tells us about the disciples' discovery of the empty tomb. It concludes by telling us they did not yet understand that Jesus had risen from the dead. Over the next 50 days, we are invited to reflect upon a most amazing gift; that is faith in Jesus and his Resurrection.

In the weeks ahead, the Gospel readings from our liturgy will show how the disciples, through His appearances to them, came to believe in Jesus' Resurrection. Our Easter faith is based on their witness to both the empty tomb and their continuing relationship with Jesus, in his appearances and in his gift of the Holy Spirit.

Anyone who needs a Letter of Eligibility or Sponsor Letter must be a **registered and participating** parishioner for at least **three (3) months**. If you are over 21 years of age you must register as your own person, you should not be under your parents' account.

All requests go through the Parish Office. Once received & processed, the Pastor will sign off and the sponsor/Godparent will pick-up the letter directly from the Pastor—Fr. Marty. **The process may take up to 2 weeks.**

What is a Spiritual Support Meeting?


