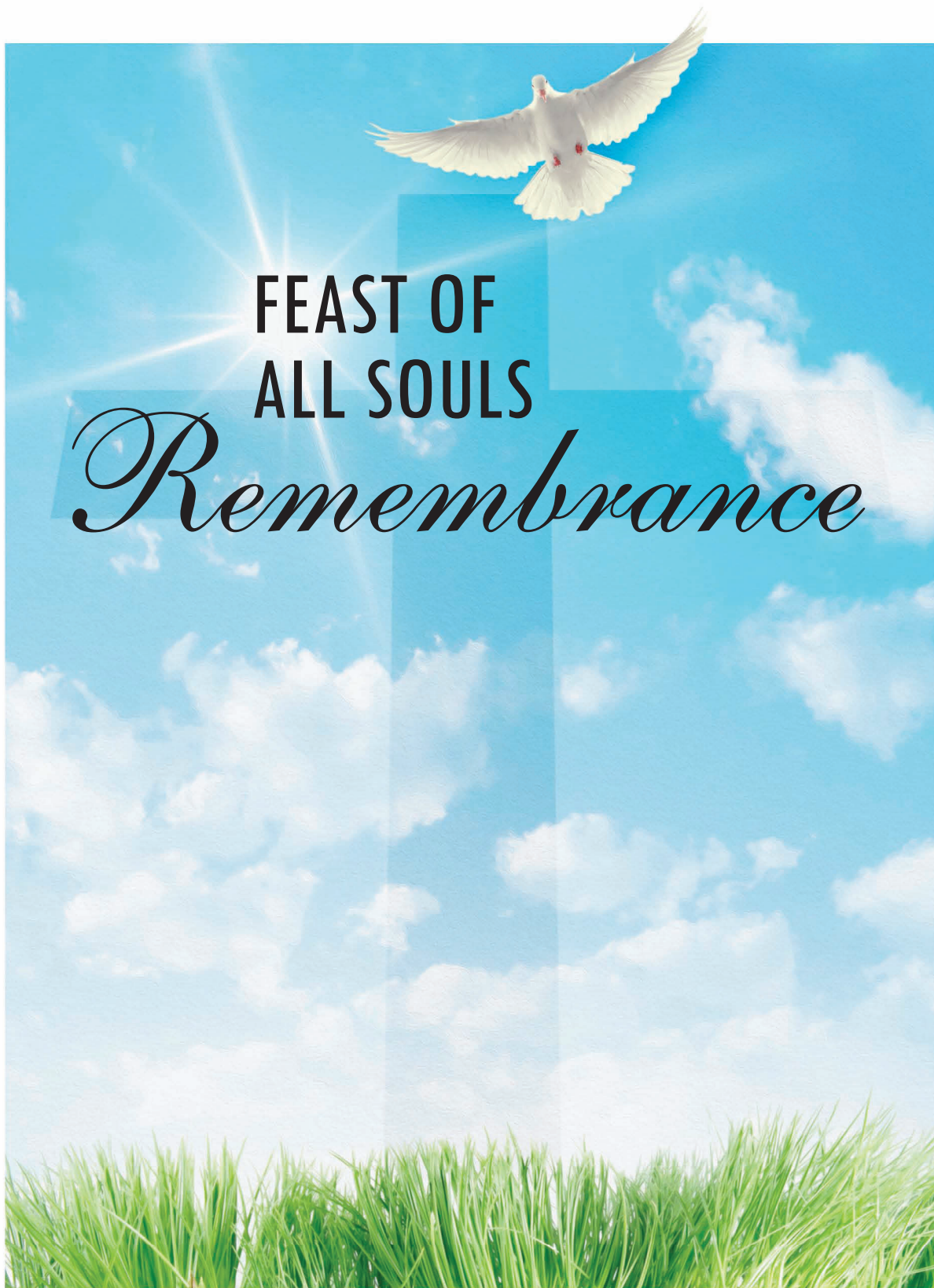

A FRESH PERSPECTIVE ON THE SUNDAY READINGS  
**HIS WORD TODAY**

**Commemoration Of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls')**

**November 2, 2025**

**“When the Lord saw her he was moved with pity for her and said ‘Do not weep’. And he said ‘Young man, I tell you arise’. The dead man sat up and began to speak and Jesus gave him to his mother. Fear seized them all, and they glorified God saying, ‘a great prophet has arisen in our midst’ and ‘God has visited his people.’”**

The scriptures tell us that it is a holy and wholesome thought to pray for the dead. In the Creed we state that we believe in the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and the life of the world to come. This weekend calls our attention to our mortality, our destiny, and also our task, to pray for those who have died, that they may know the forgiveness of our God and enjoy His presence in heaven. We do not simply recall who they were or what they accomplished but ask the loving God to take them to Himself.

Our prayer can be ‘we seem to give them back to you O Lord, who gave them to us...’



**DEDICATION OF THE LATERAN BASILICA**

**First Reading: Ezekiel 47:1-2, 8-9, 12**

This reading from the Prophet Ezekiel tells of the streaming, healing waters that flow from the temple. These waters restore life to the river's inhabitants as well as the fruit bearing trees along its banks. It is believed that the water signifies blessings, whereas the lack of signifies trouble, hardship.

**Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 3:9c-11, 16-17**

Paul compares us to a building whose foundation has been laid by Jesus. As the people of God, we can only be solid if we are grounded in Christ.

**Gospel: John 2:13-22**

Near the time of Passover, Jesus went up to Jerusalem and saw the temple had become a marketplace. He became angry and proceeded to drive out the vendors and livestock. Jesus spoke of destroying the temple and rebuilding it in three days. The Jews did not know Jesus was speaking of his body, but when his resurrection from the dead came to pass, his disciples remembered what Jesus had said and came to believe the Scripture and the word Jesus had spoken.

**REFLECTING ON THE SCRIPTURE  
READINGS BEFORE MASS**

You can enrich your experience of the Liturgy of the Word during Mass by reflecting on the Scripture readings before the Mass. It could help you to better hear what God is trying to say to you through His Word and it also gives you the opportunity to do your own study on these passages to get a better understanding of the context in which they were written. The next week's Mass readings are in the bulletin every week.
