CONSERVATION DISTRICT

In cooperation with the Luzerne County Conservation District, the Creation Care Committee of Social Justice is looking for volunteers to plant trees along Harvey's Creek in Lehman Township between April 6 to April 12. Planting trees along streams solidifies stream banks and slows rainwater runoff to trap nutrients and sediment before they flow to waterways benefiting water quality and wildlife. Volunteers need to be at least 18 years old or accompanied by an adult. The work will be laborious and workers should wear boots and older clothing. Tools, gloves, and instructions will be provided. Updated COVID Guidance for Masses

 Altar servers are no longer required to wear a mask while performing their duties but may continue to wear one if he/she wishes to do so.

• Priests, Deacons and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are no longer required to wear masks during the distribution of Holy Communion. We recognize that many of our faithful people (including those with underlying medical conditions) have found great comfort in their priest or Extraordinary Minister of Communion wearing a mask during the distribution of Holy Communion over the last several months and will take this into consideration at each mass.

• Priests, Deacons and other ministers involved in entrance/exit processions are no longer required to wear masks but may continue to wear one if they desire.

 Simply as a practice of good hygiene rather than a pandemic protocol, Priests, Deacons, and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are encouraged to continue washing or sanitizing their hands prior to the distribution of Holy Communion.
