

First Reading: Deuteronomy 4:1-2, 6-8

Moses tells the people to always observe the statutes God has given them, without adding or subtracting from these laws. He reminds them that the law is just, and that any nation who heard their statutes would consider them a wise nation.

Second Reading: James 1:17-18, 21b-22, 27

James discusses the gifts that God has given to all people and implores them to respond by welcoming the words of truth that can save them. He emphasizes that through good deeds and pure conduct, our faith in God is proven to him.

Gospel: Mark 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23

The Pharisees observed some of Jesus' disciples eating without first purifying their hands and ask the disciples why they are going against their ancestor's traditions. Jesus responds that nothing from the outside can make a person impure. The only true evil, acts such as fornication, murder, and greed among others, come from within and make a person impure.

My Dear Parishioners,

It is made clear throughout the Gospels and Epistles that our discipleship, as followers of Jesus, is not over until our bodily death. In today's second reading we are urged, "Be doers of the word and not hearers only" (James 1:22). Discipleship is hard. Sometimes we have "reasons" why we cannot do things—we are too tired, too old, too sick, too needy. We are too busy with work, with children, with other responsibilities. Yet some of the best "prayers" are people confined by illness or disability. Some of the wisest listeners are the elderly, who have a lifetime of patience and wisdom to draw upon. Some of the most generous givers are those who have endured poverty and suffering themselves. Some of the most admired organizers are those who delegate and let other people shine. And let us not forget the heroes who put their lives on the line in time of crisis. Not everyone is called to heroism, but all of us are called to live generously and selflessly. opportunities are endless: in our families, our parish, our neighborhood or town, and in places around the world. Try to balance prayer, action and financial giving. A busy mother with three toddlers can hardly spend hours in prayer or at church. A man who must work two jobs to support his family has limited time to volunteer, and a person on a tiny fixed income cannot give large donations to the church or charity. However, the busy mother can talk to God as she chases after her little ones. The hardworking man can help with an occasional parish event, and the person with a limited income can put a steady few dollars in the collection each week. Everyone can be a "doer."

So, consider—are you living your stewardship now? What is your offering of stewardship, in gratitude for God's goodness? Do you need to pull back from something, increase your giving, or change your commitments in some way?


SAN ALFONSO RETREAT HOUSE OCTOBER 1, 2024 – 9:00 AM – 3:30 PM

The fee for one child is \$180 and a family is \$250. (Books are included.)

All families attending the private schools, Saint Joseph Hill Academy, Academy of Saint Dorothy, and Notre Dame Academy, please be sure that your school knows you are a **REGISTERED and PARTICIPATING** member of Saint Ann Parish. In order for your children to be considered for the sacraments of **First Communion and Confirmation** in **2025** at Saint Ann's, you must be a **registered**, **participating** parishioner for at least six months prior to **October 2024**.
