My Dear Parishioners,

The text of this weekend's Isaiah reading speaks of a servant whose suffering and afflictions are born for the many. Father Daniel Berrigan once said that the call of the disciple of Jesus is to absorb evil. Not very glorious, indeed, for servants absorb the leftovers of the household's extravagance. Those at the bottom of life's pyramid absorb the muck; swamps and lowlands absorb the runoffs of life's fields. Just so parents absorb our tears. And those who forgive absorb the blow. As the warrior absorbs the enemy's hate, so the conscientious objector absorbs the need for revenge. So also the embrace absorbs our fears, justice absorbs mistrust. Love absorbs the distance of hearts, and the sharing of bread absorbs the memory of pain. In such ways God makes the world new.

The fear, and perhaps the sadness as well, is that in absorbing the evil of life we do become to some extent that which we absorb. Then those who gaze upon us do so as if we ourselves were afflicted and diseased. Then those who minister to dying Covid patients are themselves eyed with suspicion and fear. Then the conscientious objector is expelled by the patriot, and the selfless warrior is cast off into indifference by the righteous purist. Then the Alzheimer caregiver is forgotten; the one who forgives the abuse is revenged; and the one who combats poverty with generosity grows poorer while the hoarder is glorified. And, contradiction of contradictions, the crucified Christ becomes the Christ who reigns. And so we become like him.

Isaiah's servant sounds like the wise and wrinkled old one whose selfless devotion helped make his marriage work, one who knowingly and willingly bore the guilt of others. This is also our image of Jesus. Is our image of ourselves like it?

Keep smiling. 😊

GODPARENT/SPONSOR CERTIFICATES

When requesting a Godparent/Sponsorship Certificate, please note that the parish where you regularly attend Mass, not the parish where you received your sacraments, is the Church who issues the Sponsorship Certificate.

For those who attend Mass at St. Ann's Church, you may request a **Godparent/Sponsor Certificate** by contacting the parish office Monday to Friday, 9AM – 4PM, at 718-351-0270. In order for the parish to issue a **Godparent/Sponsor Certificate** each family and single adults must be properly registered for at least 6 months prior to the parish issuing the Certificate. In order for the Pastor and our parish priests to recognize you're a practicing Catholic, they need to see you attending Mass on a regular basis. This is the only way the parish can issue a **Godparent/Sponsor Certificate** (or other letter) stating that the person named is a practicing Catholic in good standing with the Church. In addition to attending Mass each Sunday and Holy Days, a **Godparent/Sponsor** must also be confirmed Catholic, and if married, you must be married in the Catholic Church. If your child is approaching a Sacrament for the first time, please let the **Godparent/Sponsor** candidates know of these protocols well in advance so that the candidates will have plenty of time to rectify any issues that would prevent him/her from serving as godparents.

Registration for any **First Grader and/or NEW** students entering the program is ongoing. You can contact the Religious Ed Office at **718-979-3450** or email us at saintanneled101@yahoo.com.

All new registrations must have a copy of the child’s **Baptismal Certificate** to enroll. All students transferring from another program must also have; a **transfer letter, a copy of the most current Report Card and a copy of the child’s Baptismal Certificate.** The fee for one child is \$180 and a family is \$250. (Books are included.)

All families attending the private schools, Saint Joseph Hill Academy, Academy of Saint Dorothy, and Notre Dame Academy, please be sure that your school knows you are a **REGISTERED and PARTICIPATING** member of Saint Ann Parish. In order for your children to be considered for the sacraments of **First Communion and Confirmation in 2025** at Saint Ann’s, you must be a **registered, participating** parishioner for at least six months prior to **October 2024.**

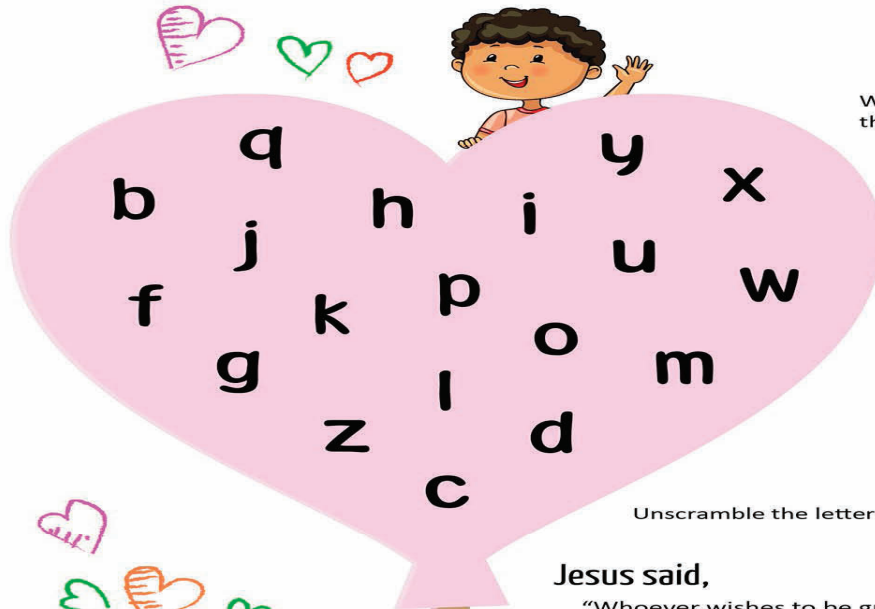

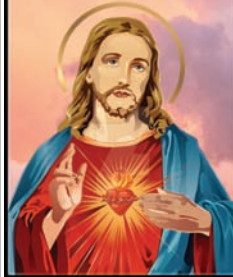
