MAY THEY REST IN THE PEACE OF GOD

With tenderness and love we pray for our deceased, **Catherine L. Cangro**. May her loved ones find comfort and reassurance in God, our Father.



My Dear Parishioners,

Jesus will ask the Father to send “another Advocate,” namely the “Spirit of truth” [John 14:16]. The Greek word for Advocate, sometimes rendered “Paraclete,” conveys multiple roles, from helper and intercessor to comforter. In calling the Spirit “another” Advocate, Jesus asserts continuity between His role [see John 2:1] and the Spirit’s.

In the 2nd reading, 1 Peter states that Jesus was “put to death in the flesh” and “brought to life in the Spirit” [3:18]. This contrast does not separate the parts of the person into flesh and Spirit. All of Jesus died, and all of Jesus rose from the dead. Spirit (the Greek word could also be translated “breath”) is here understood as an animating force that is necessary for life. It is contrasted with “flesh” because “flesh” is a hallmark of mortality.

Beginning with the story of Pentecost in Acts 2, the Book of Acts repeatedly portrays the gifting and activity of the Spirit that Jesus promised to his followers. Philip’s preaching and miracles of healing were possible because of the gift of the Spirit he received. His Spirit-filled ministry won many converts to the Church. Though they had been baptized, however, these converts had not yet received the Spirit themselves (see Acts 1:5). Echoing the story of diaconal ordination in Acts 6:1-7 and Jesus’ own actions of laying hands on the sick, this gift is conferred to them through laying on of hands. Owing in part to these stories, the hand is one of the symbols of the Holy Spirit in Catholic tradition. During the part of the Mass known as “epiclesis,” or “calling upon” God to pour out God’s Spirit, the priest’s extended hands reflect this tradition.

This Sunday’s Psalm 66 celebrates God’s mighty and saving deeds. Focusing especially on the miraculous exodus from Egypt, the psalm presents God’s liberating actions as a cause for all the earth to rejoice.

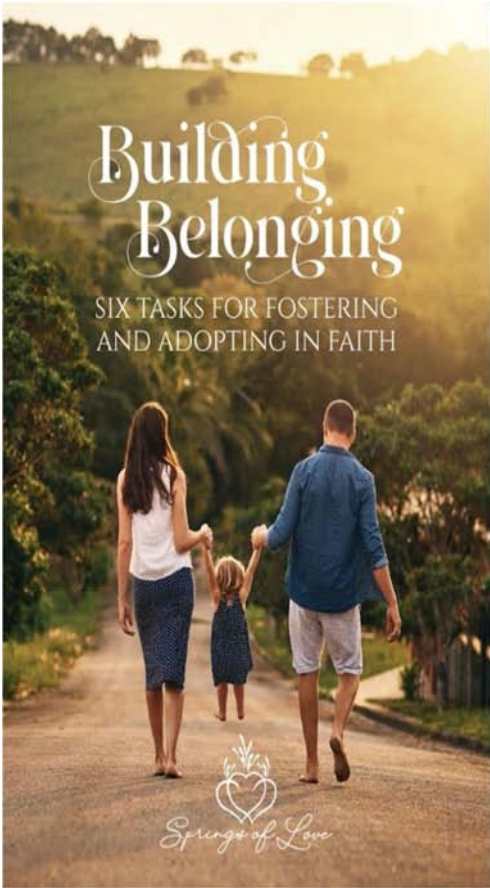

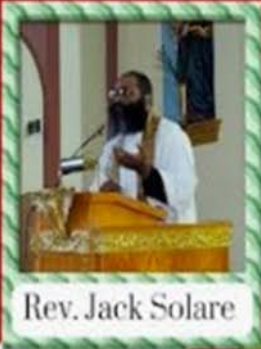

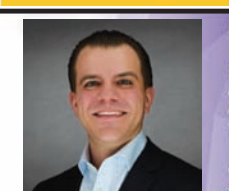
