My Dear Parishioners,

We confess our faith in the mystery of God who is Father, Son, and Holy Spirit: one God, three divine Persons, equal in majesty. The key word is mystery—not the kind of unknown to be solved but the mystery of God into which we enter. Moses encountered this mystery when God revealed his name and described himself as “merciful and gracious . . . slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity.” The God of Moses is not the God of wrath that many mistakenly see in the Old Testament but the God of mercy and fidelity.

Jesus reveals the kindness and fidelity of God when he assures us that God did not send him—the Son—into the world to condemn the world but so that the world might be saved through the Son who revealed the Father to the world.

St. Paul concludes his second letter to the Corinthians with a blessing we often hear at the beginning of Mass, which names the three divine Persons of the Trinity: “The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you.” In this blessing the apostle summarizes the incomprehensible mystery of God before whom we stand in awe and wonder. The God of Moses who is merciful and gracious is a Trinity of Persons.

In these days when some doubt and even reject the existence of God, we confess the mystery of God. In these days, when some experience no further need for God, we acknowledge the mystery of God that grounds our being, the mystery without which we cannot exist. Aware that God is always greater than what we can know and understand, we praise God in the beautiful words of today’s responsorial psalm, taken from the canticle in the Book of the prophet Daniel: “Blessed are you, praiseworthy and exulted above all forever.”

A thought to ponder—How do you experience God in your life?

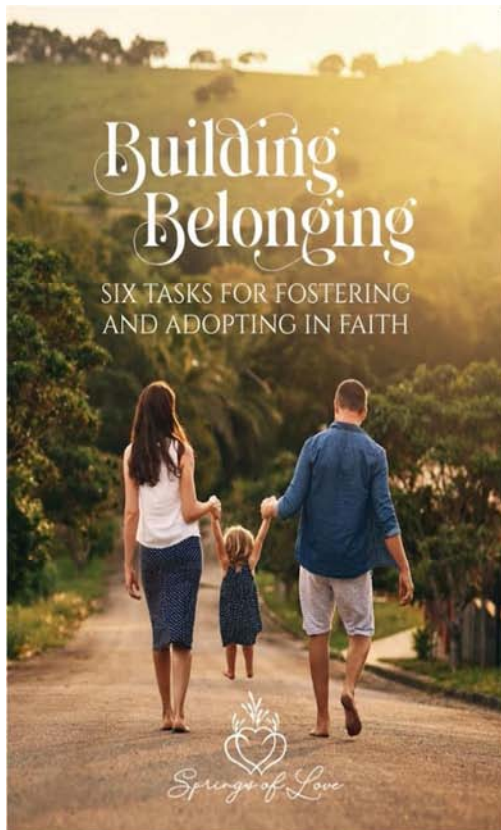

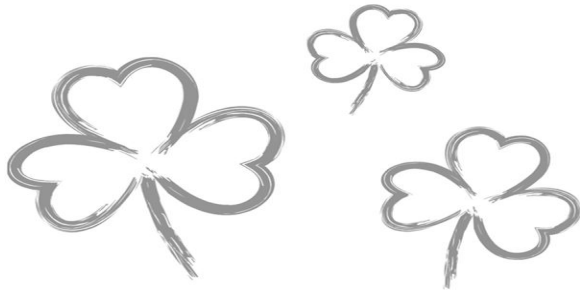

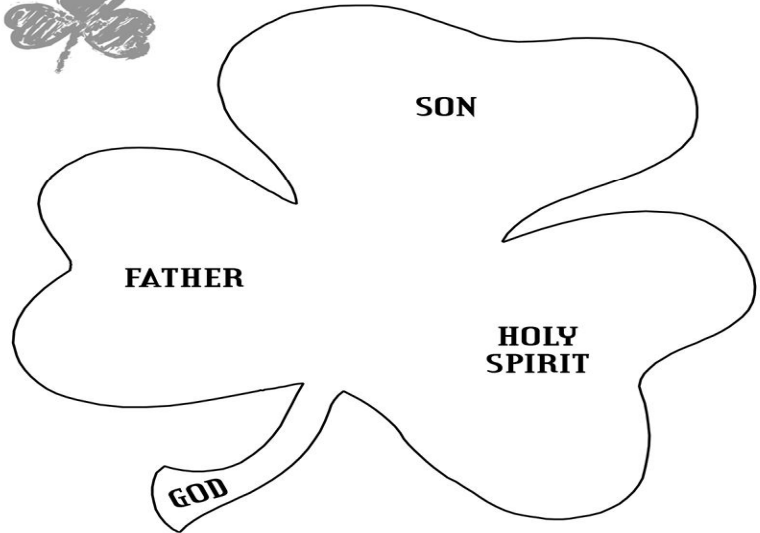
THE MOST HOLY TRINITY
