Pastor's Corner

My Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday the Lord invites Solomon to ask for whatever he wants. Although a mere youth, Solomon is wise enough to ask for an understanding heart so that he can govern God's people wisely. The Lord is pleased with Solomon's request and grants him a heart so wise and understanding so that he will always know what is wise and just.

The word understanding occurs again in the responsorial psalm. Psalm 119, the longest psalm of the Psalter, is an extensive meditation on the wisdom and beauty of God's law. Today, the worshipping community responds to the first reading by singing: "Lord, I love your commands" because, as the psalm teaches, "the revelation of your words shines light giving understanding to the simple." To understand God's law is to know what is truly right and good.

In today's Gospel, Jesus delivers three parables that reveal the mystery of the kingdom of God: the hidden treasure, the pearl of great price, and the net thrown into the sea. He then asks us: "Do you understand all these things? Do you understand that the kingdom of heaven is so precious that you ought to sell everything in order to attain it? Do you understand that there will be a final judgment, a sorting of good and evil, at the end of the age? Do you understand the message of the kingdom that I have been teaching these three weeks? If you do, you will act accordingly."

Although St. Paul does not use the word understanding, he provides us with insight to God's eternal plan for our salvation. God knew us from all eternity. Therefore, God called us, justified us, and glorified us in Jesus Christ. The goal and purpose of our lives, then, is to be glorified in and with the risen Christ. If we understand this, we will be truly wise.

Consider: What is your experience of being called, justified, and glorified in Christ?

Classes will start on Wednesday, September 16, 2026 and Thursday, September 17, 2026. The classes will be in person. The class time is from 3:30 – 5:00 P.M.

Normal office hours are Wednesday & Thursday from 12:30 to 5:00p.m., please call or email if you need to come to school. Summer Office hours will be on Wednesdays, from 9 – 11A.M.

Registration for any **First Grader and/or NEW** students entering the program is ongoing. You can contact the Religious Ed Office at 718-979-3450 or email us at saintannreled101@yahoo.com.

All new registrations must have a copy of the child's **Baptismal Certificate** to enroll. All students transferring from another program must also have; a **transfer letter, a copy of the most current Report Card and a copy of the child's Baptismal Certificate.**

The fee for one child is \$190 and a family is \$260. (Books are included.)

Please remember our program classes go from **1ST Grade thru 7TH Grade**. Skipping grades results in the student being in a class a year or in some cases two years behind when they finally come back. Our mission is to provide a continuous foundation for their faith formation.

All families attending the private schools; Saint Joseph Hill Academy, Academy of Saint Dorothy, and Notre Dame Academy, please be sure that your school knows you are a REGISTERED and PARTICIPATING MEMBER of Saint Ann Parish. That is attending Mass here at Saint Ann's.

In order for your children to be considered for the sacraments of **first Communion and Confirmation** next year in **2027** at Saint Ann's, you must be a **registered, participating parishioner.**

GODPARENT/SPONSOR CERTIFICATES

When requesting a Godparent/Sponsorship Certificate please note that you must request the Sponsorship Certificate from the parish where you regularly attend Mass, not the parish where you received your sacraments.

For those who attend Mass at St. Ann's Church, you may request a **Godparent/Sponsor Certificate** by contacting the parish office Monday to Friday, 9AM – 4PM, at 718-351-0270. In order for the parish to issue a **Godparent/Sponsor Certificate** each family and single adults must be properly registered for at least 6 months prior to the parish issuing the Certificate. In order for the Pastor and our parish priests to recognize you're a practicing Catholic, they need to see you attending Mass on a regular basis. This is the only way the parish can issue a **Godparent/Sponsor Certificate** (or other letter) declaring that the person named is a practicing Catholic in good standing with the Church. In addition to attending Mass each Sunday and Holy Days, a **Godparent/Sponsor** must also be a confirmed Catholic, and if married, you must be married in the Catholic Church. Cohabitation disqualifies a person from serving as godparent. If your child is approaching a Sacrament for the first time, please let the **Godparent/Sponsor** candidates know of these protocols well in advance so that the candidates will have plenty of time to rectify any issues that would prevent him/her from serving as godparents.

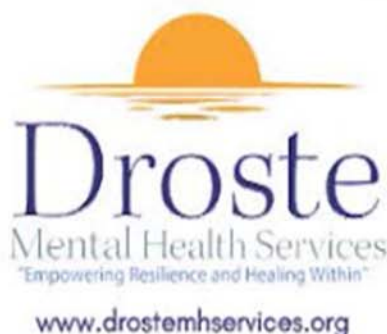

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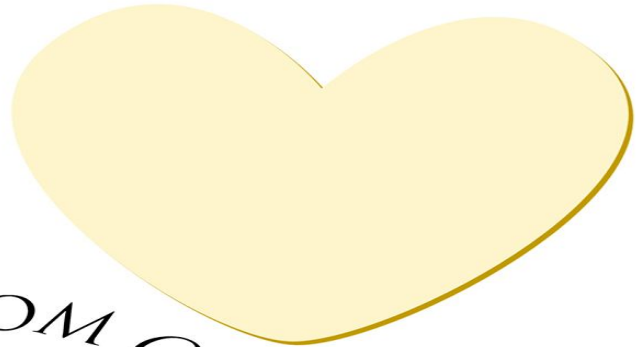
