First Reading: Sirach 27:30—28:7

Sirach advises all to forgive the faults of their neighbor. Only by forgiving the sins of others, can a person expect to be forgiven his sins.

Second Reading: Romans 14:7-9

Paul stresses that no one is his own master; we are responsible to the Lord, and we belong to him in both life and death.

Gospel: Matthew 18:21-35

This narrative points out the difference between mercy and justice. When Peter asks how often he should forgive someone who wrongs him, Jesus answers, "...not seven times: I say seventy times seven times." Jesus then narrates the story of the king who was merciful to his official by forgiving him all his debts, but this same official showed no mercy to his own servant.

My Dear Parishioners,

Erich Segal died at the beginning of 2010. I remember reading his best seller Love Story and being moved by its then famous line "Love means never having to say you're sorry." Over the years I have come to disagree with this. I believe love means having to say you're sorry and asking for forgiveness many times in life.

Today's Gospel reminds us that love also means being willing to forgive many times in life. We fail each other. We sin against each other. Sometimes we do this thoughtlessly, but nonetheless it is painful for the one sinned against.

Is forgiveness ever easy— especially with a repeat offender? "Seven times?" Peter asks. "Seventy-seven times," Jesus replies. Today's readings give us the major reason to forgive others: God has forgiven us. There's more. Not to forgive is to let anger and wrath poison our hearts. Being unforgiving is to imprison a person, resulting in bitterness, revenge and a slow death of the spirit. Not to forgive can be more costly for the one offended.

Paul tells us we belong to the Lord, are called to serve Him, to do His will, which is the will of the Father. And God's will is that we forgive one another. When the risen Lord first appeared to the disciples in the upper room, He wished them peace, and then gave the power of the Spirit to forgive. This work is not limited to going to the sacrament of reconciliation.

In living God's Word we pray that we might have the gift of forgiveness, both in receiving and giving it to others in turn. We ask the Holy Spirit to empower us to be able to forgive what the world judges to be "unforgiveable." While for us it can seem impossible, with God all things are possible.

6. Exit **after** the priest and servers, preferably at the conclusion of the recessional hymn.

Registration for any **First Grader and/or NEW** students entering the program is ongoing. You can contact the Religious Ed Office at 718-979-3450 or email us at saintannreled101@yahoo.com.

All new registrations must have a copy of the child's **Baptismal Certificate** to enroll. All students transferring from another program must also have; a **transfer letter**, a **copy of the most current Report Card** and a **copy of the child's Baptismal Certificate**.

The fee for one child is \$190 and a family is \$260. (Books are included.)

Please remember our program classes go from **1ST Grade thru 7TH Grade**. Skipping grades results in the student being in a class a year or in some cases two years behind when they finally come back. Our mission is to provide a continuous foundation for their faith formation.

All families attending the private schools; Saint Joseph Hill Academy, Academy of Saint Dorothy, and Notre Dame Academy, please be sure that your school knows you are a **REGISTERED and PARTICIPATING MEMBER** of Saint Ann Parish. **That is attending Mass here at Saint Ann's.**

In order for your children to be considered for the sacraments of **first Communion and Confirmation** next year in **2027** at Saint Ann's, you must be a **registered, participating parishioner**.

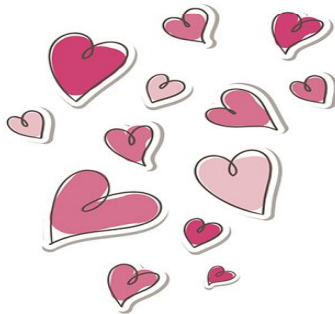
