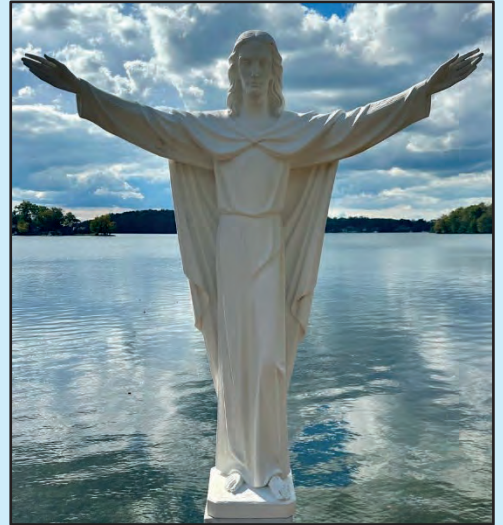

Respect Life

Today is Divine Mercy Sunday – O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in You! Let us pray for a deeper devotion to Jesus' Divine Mercy for ourselves and others.

The Dignity of Living and Dying (Part 4) – Sadly, there are physicians who see their role as assisting patients to end their own lives. What a tragedy it is that the very people trained to heal the injured and care for the sick have become dealers in death. Pope John Paul II was blunt in his condemnation. Even if a patient request assisted suicide, it remains an “inexcusable injustice.” He also left no doubt about the Church’s clear teaching regarding those in a so-called “persistent vegetative state.” Human persons are not vegetables. Such regrettable terminology may lead some to conclude falsely that these handicapped persons are more like vegetables than human beings. **This is simply not true.** All disabled persons have basic rights. These patients are human beings with the same intrinsic value and personal dignity as any other human person.

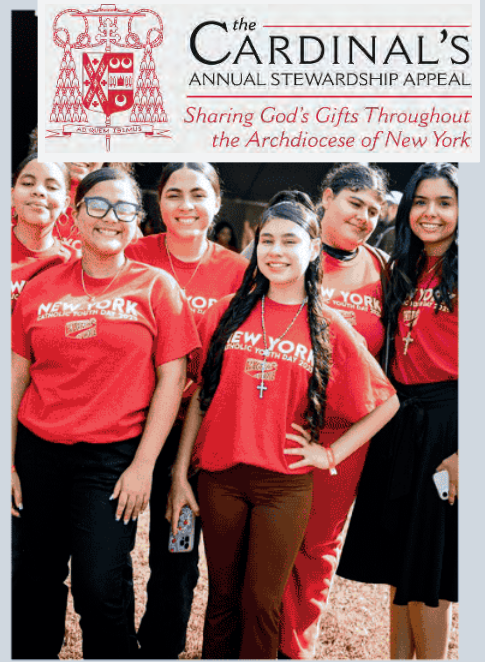
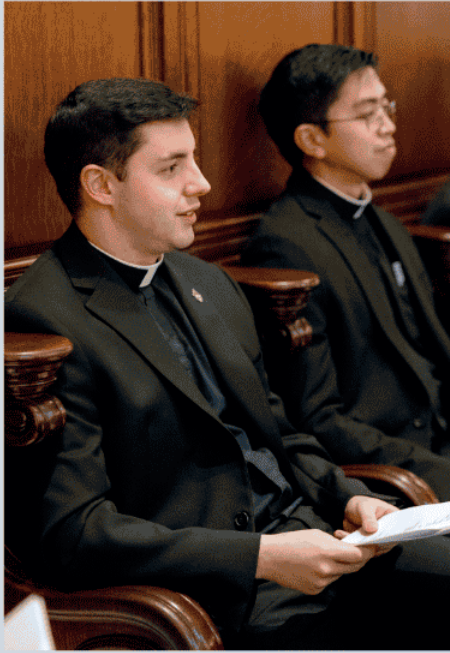

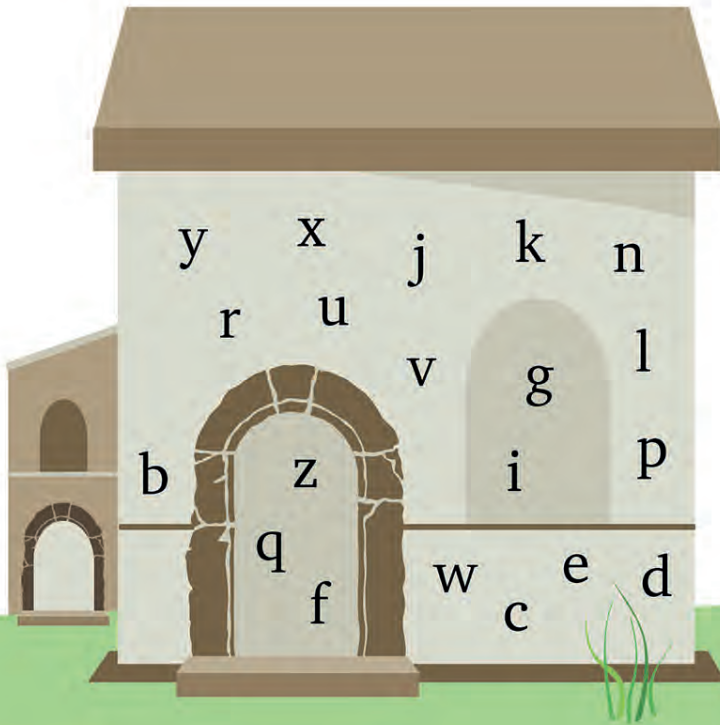
