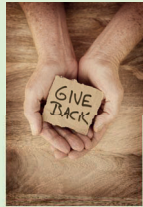

Thank you to everyone who participated in our recent Mass schedule survey. Over the last several months, we have listened carefully to your feedback, analyzed three years of attendance data, and prayed over the future of our community.

Our goal was to balance the diverse spiritual needs of our parishioners with the long-term sustainability of our parish. While we know that no schedule can perfectly accommodate every individual preference, these adjustments reflect the clearest patterns of our community's actual attendance and pastoral needs.

Beginning the week after Labor Day, St. Patrick Church will transition to our official new schedule:

Weekend Schedule

Saturday Vigil at 5:00 PM

Retained to serve our evening community.

Sunday at 8:00 AM

A quiet, simple Mass with no music or processions, mirroring a daily Mass.

Sunday at 9:30 AM

Our vibrant, community-focused Youth Mass.

Sunday at 11:00 AM

Our traditional Mass with Choir.

Please note: The Sunday 5:00 PM evening Mass has been discontinued based on long-term attendance trends.

Weekday Schedule

Monday through Friday at 8:15 AM

Adjusted specifically to accommodate our school community, allowing our children to participate in Mass and arrive at school on time.

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Appalachia Reflection

We recently heard from Steven Johnson, a man who has taken part in this mission for twenty-five years, and we wanted to share the following reflection as a way of keeping the spirit of the trip alive and encouraging the effort to continue.

Below is an excerpt from Steve:

In the 25 times I've participated in the AHW program since 2001, there have been many reasons I give for why I continue to go. This year on the ride home, another one hit me: Spending a week on this trip is like entering another world. Not the world of poverty we witness or the rivers and mountains of West Virginia, but a world of compassion, helpfulness and support, shared faith and experiences, purpose, action, friendships - and reminders of how we are called to be. It's the kind of world I'd like to live in and am thankful I get to be a part of it each summer!

As you know, each July, youth and adults of all ages participate in an annual service trip to West Virginia. This tradition began many years ago here at St. Patrick's and has since expanded to other services through Certain Place Ministries.





Mary, Mother of God

As we celebrate the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary this weekend, Knights of Columbus remember that one of the defining characteristics of the organization is its members' deep devotion to her. Every Knight receives a rosary when he joins the Order and is encouraged to turn to Mary as his own Mother, so that she may lead him closer to her Son.

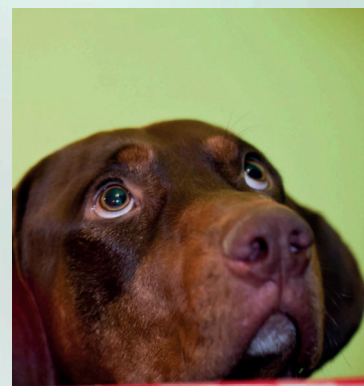

Scraps of Faith

Hearing Jesus say, "It is not right to take the food of the children and throw it to the dogs" can feel harsh and unsettling. At first glance, it doesn't seem to fit the image of a God who loves, welcomes, and cares for all. Many of us know how discouraging it can be when our prayers seem to receive a negative answer—or no answer at all. When God's response feels like silence, which is often really a "wait for My time," we can be tempted to give up.

The woman in today's Gospel refuses to give up. She acknowledges that even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from the table. Her reply is an act of humility: she recognizes that she is not entitled to Jesus' help, yet she trusts deeply that God's love extends to everyone. That trust impels her to keep asking. She knows that even a "crumb" of grace from God would be enough to heal her daughter. Jesus praises her faith, and her persistence is rewarded with the cure she sought. Her example invites us to examine our own hearts. Are we humble enough to beg God for the "crumbs" of grace we need? Do we have the faith to accept God's timing, even when it feels slow or hidden? Can we trust the God who loves us enough to believe that even a "no" can ultimately work for our good and for the good of God's kingdom?

Theo shows us what a modern-day saint next door can look like, and what can happen when one person devotes himself entirely to small, nameless, unremembered acts of kindness.

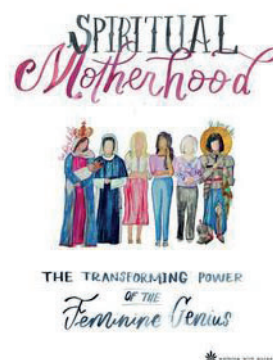
