VOCATION PRAYER CHALICE PROGRAM

As you know, our parish started a new program called the "Vocation Prayer Chalice Program." We encourage ALL Parishioners to take part in this program and to pray regularly for vocations to priesthood, diaconate, and consecrated life.

Each week a family/individual receives the Vocation Chalice at Mass to take home with a promise to "pray for vocations" during that week.

The chalice is then located in a prominent place in the home and individuals gather each day to pray, asking God to help raise awareness for vocations. The following Friday, the family brings the chalice back to the church to the Adoration Chapel so the next family can take it home. We hope that through prayer, our parish may become a source of vocations to serve our diocese and the Church.

Grief Support Group


A Place of Understanding & Sharing
