Sacrament of Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated every Sunday at 1:30 pm. Parents are required to attend an instructional class which is online (unless otherwise noted). God-parents are encouraged to attend the class if possible. Parents are asked to arrange for the child's baptism six weeks in advance. Please call the rectory.

Sacrament of Marriage: Arrangements for the Sacrament of Marriage must be made with one of the priests or deacons at least six months before the wedding.

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick: We have a communal celebration of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick at every Mass on the 3rd Sunday of each month. If you or someone you know would like to be anointed at a time other than that, please call the rectory office and speak to one of the priests.

School of Religious Education: Classes are held for 1st through 8th Grade. Children are prepared for the Sacraments of First Penance and First Holy Communion in Grade 2, and Confirmation in Grades 7 & 8.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (R.C.I.A.): Classes begin each September for those who want to complete their Sacraments of Initiation (*Baptism, Communion, and/or Confirmation*), or are interested in becoming Catholic. **Anyone who wants to learn more about our Catholic Faith is also welcome.**

The Ark & The Dove Preschool: The Ark and the Dove is St. Denis Church's own early childhood program. We offer a variety of Preschool programs for 2, 3, and 4 year-olds.

St. Denis-St. Columba School: St. Denis-St. Columba School provides a Catholic, Christian education for children in grades K-8. For more information call 227-7777.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

I have to share some news with you today that is a bit sad to accept: after many years of faithfully assisting the St. Denis parish family, Deacon Enrico Messina has informed Fr. Pat and me that he wishes to retire from his diaconal service effective January 3, 2022. He needs to spend more time with his family, which is his first vocation, and I completely understand his needs. I am going to personally feel the loss. Since I came here in July, Deacon Enrico has been my "go to" man for almost everything. He knows every lock, every bolt, every person in St. Denis, and his service to me has been invaluable. If he's done that for me in five months, I can only imagine what he has done for all the people of St. Denis that he has served since he was ordained a deacon on June 11, 2005, and in the many years that he was active here before his ordination. During his time at St. Denis, which began in 1972, he has served as an Extraordinary Minister of the Eucharist, especially in visiting the homebound, the elderly, and the sick. He also provided the training for our other Extraordinary Ministers, and continues to serve the sick and hospitalized at Vassar Hospital, which he has done for 35 years. He has been the focal point of our First Friday Adoration and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament, bringing a much-needed awareness of the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist into our community, and has helped in numerous administrative positions in the parish, especially in the cemetery office. These are just a few of his contributions.

Is it at all possible to say thank you to Deacon Enrico in an adequate manner? I know you will join me in thanking him for his tireless devotion to Christ and the people of St. Denis Parish and beyond. He has been an exemplary deacon, a model Christian and a faithful disciple of Jesus. Good Deacon Enrico, thank you for your tremendous service to us all! We will be forever grateful for all you have done, and we wish you and your wife Susan health, happiness, and holiness in your retirement. Thank you, Deacon Enrico! You are a wonderful man!!!

BRIEF SYNOPSIS OF SUNDAY READINGS

First Reading: Micah 5:1-4a

Micah speaks of the ruler who will come from Bethlehem. He discusses how the people of Israel will be saved from corruption and live in peace.

Second Reading: Hebrews 10:5-10

Paul describes to the Hebrews how Jesus came into the world and offered to do God's will. We were saved through his sacrifice, the only offering sufficient for the sins of the world.

Gospel: Luke 1:39-45

Mary paid a visit to Elizabeth, whose baby stirred in her womb upon hearing Mary's greeting. Elizabeth filled with the Holy Spirit, cried out, "Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb." Elizabeth was deeply overjoyed that the words God had spoken to Mary had now been fulfilled.
