Sacrament of Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated every Sunday at 1:30 pm. Parents are required to attend an instructional class which is online (unless otherwise noted). God-parents are encouraged to attend the class if possible. Parents are asked to arrange for the child's baptism six weeks in advance. Please call the rectory.

Sacrament of Marriage: Arrangements for the Sacrament of Marriage must be made with one of the priests or deacons at least six months before the wedding.

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick: We have a communal celebration of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick at every Mass on the 3rd Sunday of each month. If you or someone you know would like to be anointed at a time other than that, please call the rectory office and speak to one of the priests.

School of Religious Education: Classes are held for 1st through 8th Grade. Children are prepared for the Sacraments of First Penance and First Holy Communion in Grade 2, and Confirmation in Grades 7 & 8.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (R.C.I.A.): Classes begin each September for those who want to complete their Sacraments of Initiation (*Baptism, Communion, and/or Confirmation*), or are interested in becoming Catholic. **Anyone who wants to learn more about our Catholic Faith is also welcome.**

The Ark & The Dove Preschool: The Ark and the Dove is St. Denis Church's own early childhood program. We offer a variety of Preschool programs for 2, 3, and 4 year-olds.

St. Denis-St. Columba School: St. Denis -St. Columba School provides a Catholic, Christian education for children in grades K-8. For more information call 227-7777.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Anyone driving into the campus of St. Denis right away sees our sign that informs them that we have a preschool program here, The Ark & The Dove. I wrote about our program in last week's column. This week, I want to remind everyone that we also have an elementary school at St Denis: St. Denis-St. Columba School. Many people are probably not aware that we have a parish school because it is located on the grounds of our daughter parish, St. Columba. I take a personal and active interest in St. Denis-St. Columba school, and teach the 5th and 7th grades religion once a week. Fr. Michael McLoughlin, the Pastor of St. Columba parish and his assistant, Fr. Walter Genito, both teach three religion classes, so every grade has a priest coming in to teach them once a week. They have frequent confessions and a wonderful school spirit. I have been extremely impressed by the knowledge of the children in our school. I am amazed at the amount of knowledge of the faith that the children possess, and I commented to Fr. McLoughlin that someone has done a wonderful job teaching them our beliefs. We have good sized classes and an excellent principal in Sr. Kathleen Gerritse. Earlier this month I was pleased to attend their drama club production of "Matilda – the Musical" and found it amazing.

I am not familiar enough with the local public schools to know how effective their education system is, and I certainly intend no animosity toward them (I hope they are excellent schools), but with other public school districts in previous parishes where I have been assigned I have found myself in a battle to defend our moral beliefs and to prevent school districts from indoctrinating our children with beliefs that contradict ours. The news is filled with stories of districts across the country that are doing precisely that, and parents are beginning to fight back. By sending your children to a Catholic school, you can be assured that they will be taught the Catholic morals and values that we espouse, and will never be taught anything that contradicts them.

I encourage all parents to consider a Catholic education for your children. This is one of the greatest investments you can make for your children, and financial aid is available. Please visit our parish website and select the link under Educational Ministries for full information.



PENTECOST

Happy birthday to the Catholic Church! Happy birthday to you, who are the body of the Church!

We're all familiar with our own birthdays, and we celebrate them because they mark the day of the year in which we entered into this life. But did you know you have a second birthday?

Because you are part of the body of the Church, Pentecost is the Church's birthday, and yours as well. And like any birthday, it's a cause for celebration. The word Pentecost is Greek and it means "50th day." Fifty days after Easter Sunday, we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and their followers, and the beginning of their Earthly ministry to make disciples of all nations.

Pentecost is also a Jewish holiday, which the Jews use to celebrate the end of Passover. Jews celebrate the gift of the law to Moses at Mt. Sinai on this day. But we, as Catholics celebrate the birth of our Church.

At Pentecost, the Apostles and their followers were gathered in a room. Jews from all over the world were gathered with Peter, the leader of the Apostles and the Eleven. At this time, a great wind blew and a flame appeared as a tongue of fire, which split itself into many individual flames above the heads of all those present. The Holy Spirit came upon these people and each began to speak in tongues. Despite the fact many had no common language, they were perfectly able to understand one another.

Others who were not so blessed, accused those speaking in tongues of being drunk, but Peter arose and addressed the crowd, explaining that it was only 9 o'clock, and that this phenomenon was not intoxication, but rather this was the work of the Holy Spirit, prophesized in the scripture.

Peter then called all those present to be baptized and about three thousand people were baptized that day. These people were among the first Catholics, and Peter is the first pope of the Catholic Church.

The symbols of Pentecost are the flame, wind, and the dove, which represents the Holy Spirit. The color of Pentecost is red and the priest wears red vestments on this day. Parishioners are also invited to wear red on this day. Red decorations as well as celebrations are appropriate, similar to any other birthday. Special prayers are often said just for Pentecost.

Many of our Eucharistic Ministers visit those who are homebound or are in the hospital or nursing homes.

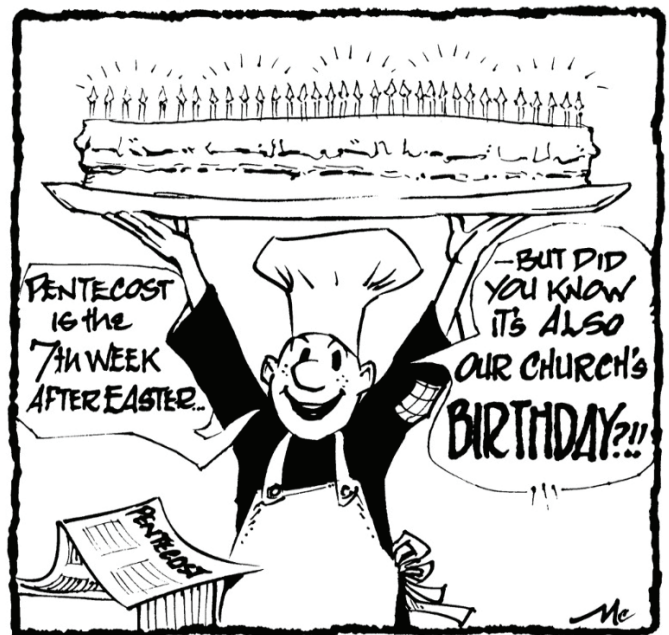
