**Sacrament of Baptism:** The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated every Sunday at 1:30 pm. Parents are required to attend an instructional class which is online (unless otherwise noted). God-parents are encouraged to attend the class if possible. Parents are asked to arrange for the child's baptism six weeks in advance. Please call the rectory.

**Sacrament of Marriage:** Arrangements for the Sacrament of Marriage must be made with one of the priests or deacons at least six months before the wedding.

**Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick:** We have a communal celebration of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick at every Mass on the 3rd Sunday of each month. If you or someone you know would like to be anointed at a time other than that, please call the rectory office and speak to one of the priests.

**School of Religious Education:** Classes are held for 1st through 8th Grade. Children are prepared for the Sacraments of First Penance and First Holy Communion in Grade 2, and Confirmation in Grades 7 & 8.

**Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (O.C.I.A.):** Classes begin each September for those who want to complete their Sacraments of Initiation (*Baptism, Communion, and/or Confirmation*), or are interested in becoming Catholic. **Anyone who wants to learn more about our Catholic Faith is also welcome.**

**The Ark & The Dove Preschool:** The Ark and the Dove is St. Denis Church's own early childhood program. We offer a variety of Preschool programs for 2, 3, and 4 year-olds.

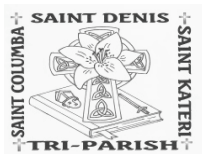

**Holy Hour on Monday, December 29th**

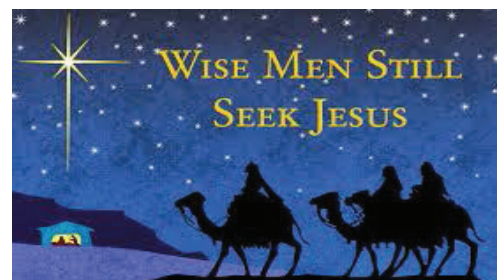
The Tri-Parish Respect Life Group will pay homage to the children murdered by King Herod in his attempt to kill the *Baby Jesus* and for today's abortion victims.
