

First Reading: Isaiah 53:10-11

ANNUAL HOLIDAY CRAFT FAIR Divine Mercy Parish


On Saturday, November 9, from 9:00 AM until 2:00 PM, SS Peter & Paul Rosary Sodality is sponsoring a Holiday
