SACRAMENTS

The Sacrament of Baptism is administered on Sundays at 1:00 pm. First time parents must attend a Baptism preparation program. Godparents are also welcome to attend this class. Please call the parish office to arrange for the baptism of your child and to register for the class.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is ordinarily administered on Saturdays after the 8:00 am Mass and again from 3:45 to 4:30 pm.

Sacraments of the Sick are administered upon request. Please call the parish office to arrange for Holy Communion to be brought on Sunday mornings to those either temporarily or permanently housebound. If preferred, a family member can be designated to do this. We want all of our housebound members to have the opportunity to receive Holy Communion every Sunday.

The Sacrament of Marriage must be arranged six months ahead of time. One of the couple must be a member of the parish. The times for Saturday weddings are 10:00 am, 12:00 & 2:00 pm. Friday evening weddings can also be arranged.

Eucharistic Adoration: Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is available twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week, in our Chapel of the Most Blessed Sacrament. Entrance to the chapel is the second door to the left of our school's main entrance. You will need to key in the code number followed by the star. Please contact the parish office for the code number. For the sake of security, we are refraining putting the code number in written form.

Holy Communion: We have very low gluten hosts available for any parishioner who needs them. Please come to the sacristy prior to the Mass and let the priest know you require a low gluten host. These hosts are approved by the Celiac Society.

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

As our new community center nears completion, we are going to get serious about donor recognition. We will have a donor recognition board for those who have contributed ten thousand dollars or more. We will also have souvenir booklets in which all donors will be recognized on the day of dedication of the new building. It is my hope that our Archbishop Nelson J. Perez will be able to be with us for the dedication.

As I have told you before, our capital campaign has essentially failed. Our feasibility study indicated that we should be able to raise \$3.2 Million in pledges. The actual figure was more like \$1.2 Million. I feel like that Catholic Foundation let us down—especially since they were the ones that had told us that \$3.3 Million would be feasible. Well, there is no point in crying over the past. We need to deal with the present. I am looking to our pastoral council to help us raise at least another million dollars. So far, we were gifted with an anonymous gift of \$100,000 with the hope that this would be a challenge grant for others to step forward. Just this week a parishioner made a donation of appreciated stock. This could be especially helpful as income tax days are approaching. For more information about how you could do this, please contact our finance manager Deb Rios at our parish office.

We are coming to a conclusion with improvements in the Church. As I noted last week, our Eucharistic Adoration Chapel of the Most Blessed Sacrament is again open. If you do not know or if you forgot the code to enter the chapel, call our parish office. When all the Church renovations are finished, my classmate and friend Bishop Edward Deliman has agreed to come for a blessing.

Finally, let me remind you that because of the early Easter this year, we also have an early Lent. Lent begins on Valentine's Day this year, February 14th. I will speak more about that next week. I would ask that you put the first week of March on your calendar for our parish mission given by Monsignor Stephen McHenry on March 4, 5, and 6 at 7 p.m. Monsignor McHenry will be speaking at all of the Masses on the first weekend in March. You will find him an interesting speaker. It is my special hope that this will be a spark in our devotion especially to the Holy Eucharist. We only had a few people respond to what I was calling Operation Good Shepherd to bring back people who no longer practice their faith. Why don't you informally invite your friends and neighbors to the parish mission. I think they will be pleased they came. God bless you and your families.
