— SACRAMENTS —

The Sacrament of Baptism is administered on Sundays at 1:00 pm. First time parents must attend a Baptism preparation program. Godparents are also welcome to attend this class. Please call the parish office to arrange for the baptism of your child and to register for the class.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is ordinarily administered on Saturdays after the 8:00 am Mass and again from 3:45 to 4:30 pm.

Sacraments of the Sick are administered upon request. Please call the parish office to arrange for Holy Communion to be brought on Sunday mornings to those either temporarily or permanently housebound. If preferred, a family member can be designated to do this. We want all of our housebound members to have the opportunity to receive Holy Communion every Sunday.

The Sacrament of Marriage must be arranged six months ahead of time. One of the couple must be a member of the parish. The times for Saturday weddings are 10:00 am, 12:00 & 2:00 pm. Friday evening weddings can also be arranged.

Eucharistic Adoration: Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is available twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week, in our Chapel of the Most Blessed Sacrament. Entrance to the chapel is the second door to the left of our school's main entrance. You will need to key in the code number followed by the star. Please contact the parish office for the code number. For the sake of security, we are refraining putting the code number in written form.

Holy Communion: We have very low gluten hosts available for any parishioner who needs them. Please come to the sacristy prior to the Mass and let the priest know you require a low gluten host. These hosts are approved by the Celiac Society.

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

This is sacrament season. On Saturday, April 27th, our children in the upper grades of our school received the Sacrament of Confirmation from Archbishop Edward Adams. Archbishop Adams is a retired papal nuncio, that is ambassador, to a number of countries. His last post was in Great Britain.

Confirmation celebrates the special gift of the Holy Spirit which completes our baptism. When I was a child, Confirmation was looked upon as almost a military concept. Children used to be told, "Confirmation makes us strong and perfect Christians and soldiers of Jesus Christ." That could actually be a good way of looking at the sacrament in today's world in which we live. There is a need for Catholics to be stronger in their faith and to be zealous in bringing their faith to others.

Next Saturday we have First Holy Communion. This is always a special day in our parish. For the first time in many years, First Holy Communion will be on the first Saturday of May. The reason for the switch is so that the children will be more easily able to attend the celebration the next day at the 10 am Mass with the reception afterwards.

I tell the children that First Holy Communion is my happiest day in the year. It is a real pleasure to give the Sacrament of Jesus Himself to the children. It makes me think of my own First Communion and how special that day was for me. I invite you to think of your own First Communion Day. Almost all of us have a memory of that day. It is important that we never take for granted the special graces that flow our way whenever we receive the Body of Christ.

I hope you are getting excited as we look forward to the completion of our new community center and gymnasium. Our children have had their last play in Trainer Hall. Next year the play will be on the stage of the new center. Construction is due to be completed early in the summer. When I have a firm date for the project to be finished, I will invite Archbishop Perez to come and bless the building. For many years we had to do without a building like this. Now we will have a center and a gymnasium of which we will all be proud. For those of you who have been waiting to make sure the building will be coming to reality, I invite you to make or increase your pledge. We still need funds to get the project completed. The changes in the Church have all been made. Soon our entire building program will be complete.

As we reach the month of May, I invite you to take one of the envelopes at the doors of the Church for Mother's Day remembrances. Please inscribe the names of your mothers and of the special women in your lives on the envelopes. We will have them on the altar from Mother's Day until the end of May. Although it has been customary to place a financial donation in the envelopes, it is not necessary to do so. This is not a parish collection. Any donations in the envelopes will be used for Mass intentions for your Mothers, Godmothers, Grandmothers, and other special women in your lives.

May the Lord continue to bless you and your families.
