— SACRAMENTS —

The Sacrament of Baptism is administered on Sundays at 1:00 pm. First time parents must attend a Baptism preparation program. Godparents are also welcome to attend this class. Please call the parish office to arrange for the baptism of your child and to register for the class.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is ordinarily administered on Saturdays after the 8:00 am Mass and again from 3:45 to 4:30 pm.

Sacraments of the Sick are administered upon request. Please call the parish office to arrange for Holy Communion to be brought on Sunday mornings to those either temporarily or permanently housebound. If preferred, a family member can be designated to do this. We want all of our housebound members to have the opportunity to receive Holy Communion every Sunday.

The Sacrament of Marriage must be arranged six months ahead of time. One of the couple must be a member of the parish. The times for Saturday weddings are 10:00 am, 12:00 & 2:00 pm. Friday evening weddings can also be arranged.

Eucharistic Adoration: Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is available twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week, in our Chapel of the Most Blessed Sacrament. Entrance to the chapel is the second door to the left of our school's main entrance. You will need to key in the code number followed by the star. Please contact the parish office for the code number. For the sake of security, we are refraining putting the code number in written form.

Holy Communion: We have very low gluten hosts available for any parishioner who needs them. Please come to the sacristy prior to the Mass and let the priest know you require a low gluten host. These hosts are approved by the Celiac Society.

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

As you know, the Holy Eucharist is at the center of the Catholic faith. The Eucharistic Congress held recently in Indianapolis was an opportunity to deepen the faith of the Catholic people in the Eucharist as the Body and Blood of Christ. You may have seen some of it on EWTN. People I know who attended the Congress tell me that their faith was invigorated. This week I will touch on some of the questions we receive regarding the Eucharist.

We often get questions like these: Are non-Catholic people permitted to receive Holy Communion in the Catholic Church and if I go to a non-Catholic Church, may I receive Communion in their Church. I have had both of these questions asked of me in the past.

I will go with the first question first. It simply has to do with our understanding of the Eucharist. We Catholics believe in what we call *Transubstantiation*. It's a big word that means that the bread and wine consecrated at Mass become the Body and Blood of Christ. That means that the same Jesus who walked the streets of Nazareth, who died on the cross for us, and who rose from the dead, is present on our altars. It is for that reason that we place sacred hosts which have not been consumed in the tabernacle where we have a light burning to symbolize that Christ is truly present. Holy Communion also is the sign of unity among Catholics. In other words, by receiving Holy Communion, you also profess your faith in the Catholic Church and all that it believes. For that reason, it is inappropriate for someone who is not Catholic to receive Holy Communion. Even if they believed that the Eucharist is truly the body of Christ, they still lack communion with all Catholic believers.

Also, we urge all Catholics not married in the Catholic Church to have their marriages validated (commonly called "blessed"). That will open the door to their being able to receive Holy Communion. If one or both were previously married, it would be good to set up an appointment with one of our priests or deacons. It is not as complicated a procedure as it once was, and there is no cost involved.

A women recently told me that she went to a Lutheran Church to see her granddaughter sing in the choir at the service. The minister announced that all Christians were invited to communion. In such a circumstance, should the Catholic person take communion? The answer is no for two reasons. The first is that most Protestant Churches do not believe that the bread and wine actually become the Body and Blood of Christ. They treat the bread and wine (sometimes grape juice) with special reverence, but when the service is over, they place what is left back in the cabinet in their sacristy. In other words, the meaning of the bread and wine is changed in the service, but the substance is still bread and wine. The other reason you should refrain from receiving Holy Communion in a Protestant Church is that your beliefs as a Catholic are different than theirs. Is it a sin if you take Communion in a Protestant Church? It might have been considered that way in a non-ecumenical age, but it wouldn't be considered that today. It is, on the other hand, inappropriate to do so. One thing is clear: It is not appropriate to attend a Protestant service instead of a Catholic Mass. If, out of fraternal charity, you attend a Protestant service, you should also attend Mass that day.
