— SACRAMENTS —

The Sacrament of Baptism is administered on Sundays at 1:00 pm. First time parents must attend a Baptism preparation program. Godparents are also welcome to attend this class. Please call the parish office to arrange for the baptism of your child and to register for the class.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is ordinarily administered on Saturdays after the 8:00 am Mass and again from 3:45 to 4:30 pm.

Sacraments of the Sick are administered upon request. Please call the parish office to arrange for Holy Communion to be brought on Sunday mornings to those either temporarily or permanently housebound. If preferred, a family member can be designated to do this. We want all of our housebound members to have the opportunity to receive Holy Communion every Sunday.

The Sacrament of Marriage must be arranged six months ahead of time. One of the couple must be a member of the parish. The times for Saturday weddings are 10:00 am, 12:00 & 2:00 pm. Friday evening weddings can also be arranged.

Eucharistic Adoration: Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is available twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week, in our Chapel of the Most Blessed Sacrament. Entrance to the chapel is the second door to the left of our school's main entrance. You will need to key in the code number followed by the star. Please contact the parish office for the code number. For the sake of security, we are refraining putting the code number in written form.

Holy Communion: We have very low gluten hosts available for any parishioner who needs them. Please come to the sacristy prior to the Mass and let the priest know you require a low gluten host. These hosts are approved by the Celiac Society.

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ.

When I was younger, there were prayers added to the end of a "Low Mass." At that time, whenever there was singing at Mass, it was considered a "High Mass." As a choir boy, I always attended a sung Mass. In that light, I only experienced these prayers in the summertime. These were known as the Leonine Prayers. After every Low Mass, the priest would lead the congregation in praying the Hail Mary three times, the Hail Holy Queen, and the prayer to Saint Michael the Archangel. These prayers were suppressed in 1964 by the second Vatican council.

More recently, there has been a return in many parishes to only part of these prayers, the prayer to Saint Michael the Archangel. The original prayers were started by the last Pope named Leo before the current Pope Leo XIV.

In our parish, certain groups of people have taken it upon themselves to say the prayer to Saint Michael after Mass. Shortly before I got sick, I did receive a letter from a parishioner indicating her desire to have the prayer to Saint Michael said after Mass. This was the only communication I had from any parishioner. To my surprise, a few parishioners have approached me asking why I do not like the prayer to Saint Michael. I am not against any prayer. Unfortunately, I got sick last year around this time. I wasn't here to deal with the desire of some people to start including the prayer of Saint Michael before or after Mass. Directives from the Archdiocese are that this prayer may be said before or after any Mass. They are not to be included within the Mass.

In line with the directives from the Archdiocese, indicating that the prayer to Saint Michael be included before or after Mass, my preference is that the prayer be said before the Mass. When I was ordained, we were told that nothing should be added to the Mass. When the Priest or Deacon told the people to go in the peace of Christ, the only prayer that was to be used was the concluding hymn. In that light, the place for the prayer to Saint Michael would more appropriately be said before Mass. In a few weeks, we will be saying this prayer publicly before Mass. In the interim, I would ask those who have taken it upon themselves to pray this prayer publicly to say the prayer privately until we find a way to have the lector begin the prayer prior to each Mass. The prayer to Saint Michael is on the back of the Breaking Bread prayer and hymnal books which are available at any of our Masses.

It was just one year ago that my hip surgery went bad and got infected. I never realized how quickly my life could change by something like that. I am so much looking forward to the things I missed last year. At the same time, I am so grateful to Father Sang who has kept our parish together during this time. May God continue to bless all of you and your families.
